



BATTLE *of* BOSWORTH


Battle of Bosworth and Spring Seed Wine Co makes organically grown wines from our family vineyards located in McLaren Vale, South Australia.

Battle of Bosworth was established in 2001 by Joch Bosworth and Louise Hemsley-Smith, and makes their wines using vineyards established in the 1970's by Joch's parents. Battle of Bosworth takes its name from the original Battle of Bosworth, fought on Bosworth Field, Leicestershire, England in 1485.

The Spring Seed wines are also made from our organically grown grapes. The labels for these wines were inspired by turn of the last century flower seed packets. Each Spring Seed wine — 'Scarlet Runner' Shiraz, 'Forget-me-not' Sauvignon Blanc Semillon, 'Four O'clock' Chardonnay, 'Sweet Pea' Moscato, 'Poppy' Pinot Grigio, 'Cockscomb' Cabernet Sauvignon and 'Aster' Pinot Noir features three different flower seed labels per bottling.

Joch began converting our vineyards to organic viticulture in 1995, so now all of our vines are certified 100% organic by Australian Certified Organic. Our wines are made with flavour, texture, purity and balance, to best express the unique characteristics of their McLaren Vale foothills site.

Cellar door is open daily from 11-5pm and is located in a converted 1850's chaff shed and stables at the end of a tree lined drive at 92 Gaffney Road, Willunga, South Australia.
