

VINIFICATION & WINEMAKING

The 2025 vintage was warm and dry, with below-average rainfall across much of South Australia. Cool evening breezes preserved freshness and balance, while steady ripening delivered fruit of excellent colour and concentration. Fermentation was managed to retain vibrancy, and select parcels were matured in oak to build structure and depth. The result is a refined, expressive Cabernet Sauvignon showing richness, balance, and distinctive regional character.

COLOUR

Blood ruby with black garnet hues.

NOSE

Lifted aromas of rose petals, fresh strawberry, and elegant oak, creating an inviting and complex bouquet.

PALATE

The palate reveals dark cherry, strawberry, and white pepper, with subtle hints of freshly baked biscuit. Balanced acidity and velvety, well integrated tannins provide structure and depth to the wine's medium, well weighted body.

FOOD MATCH

Barbeque sirloin steak with rich mushroom sauce or slow cooked lamb shank.
