Our History

Celebrating 60 years and four generations, the Byrne family range of wines express our dedication to sustainability and land regeneration practices, with our ethos to minimise harm and maximise benefits to the environment.

In 1960, Eric and Romla Byrne purchased a property in the Devlin's Pound area near Waikerie in South Australia where they planted a vineyard. Here began the Byrne family passion for wine and viticulture. This passion continues to thrive through their granddaughter, Byrne CEO, Petria.

During the 1970s, the Scotts Creek vineyard, where Byrne Vineyards now resides, was established by then owners, Penfold's. The site was chosen due to its close proximity to the Barossa Valley, the excellent limestone soils and an ideal climate for premium wine production.

The Byrne family acquired this property in 2001 and over the last few years have adopted innovative sustainability practices allowing water to be returned to the natural environment and preserving our wetlands.



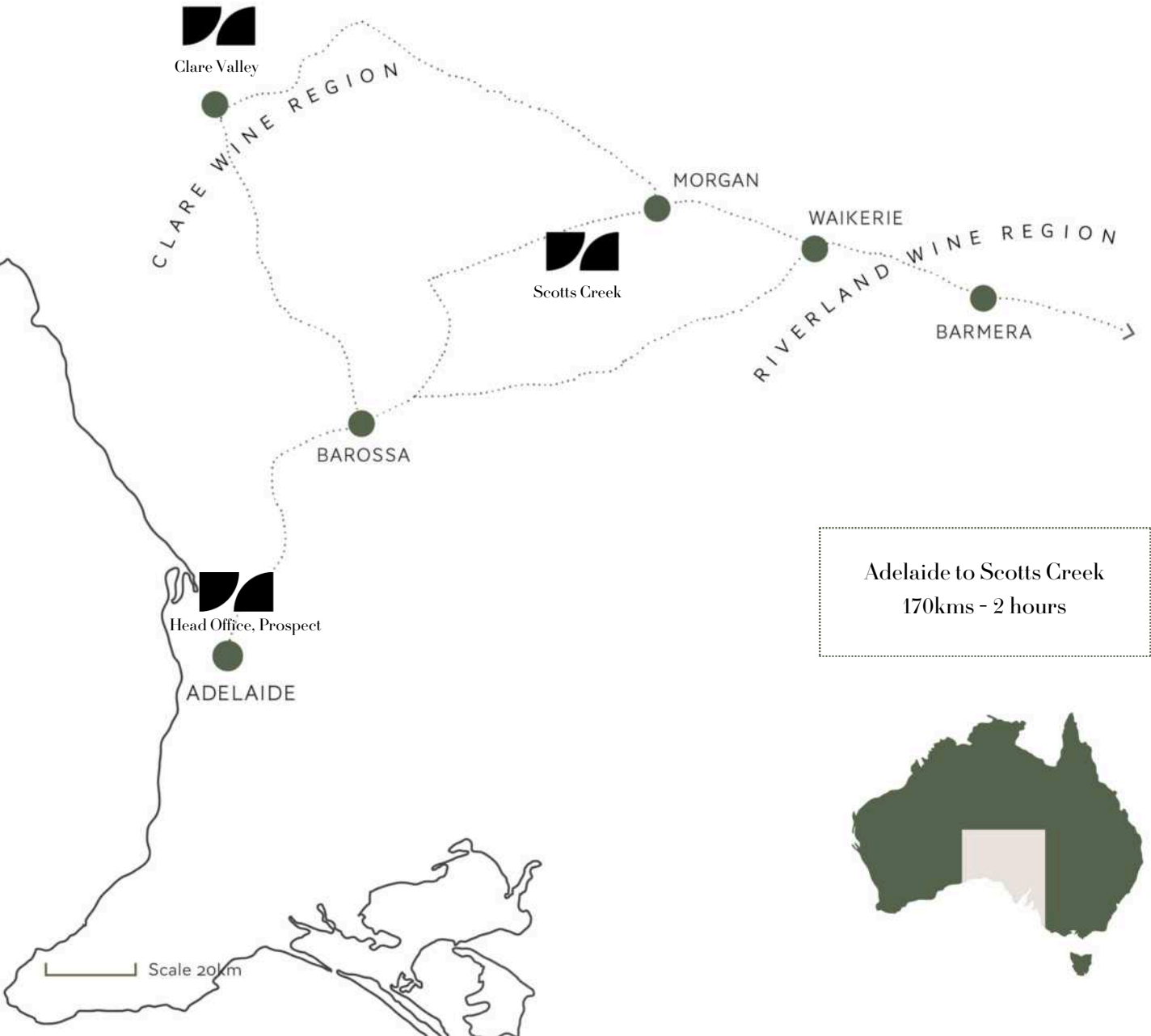

Hermann Von Rieben settles Scotts Creek property, building the first post office in the Riverland, a hotel and home.

1906

Sidney Wilcox purchases the property and builds Wilcox Homestead "Mulyoulpko". Wilcox plants fruits and vegetables for the Adelaide market.

Byrne family plants their first vines at Glen Devlin near Waikerie SA.

Penfolds plant vines at the Scotts Creek property under the direction of Max Schubert and Di Davidson.

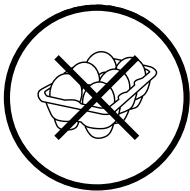

Vegan Wines

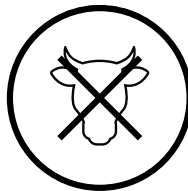
At Byrne Vineyards, we specialise in crafting vegan-friendly wines. This means that our winemaking process excludes the use of any animal-derived products or by-products. Instead, we rely on natural and plant-based fining agents to clarify and refine our wines.

Fining agents are processing aids which are mostly used to filter or fine the wine. We do not use these allergens during production of our wines:



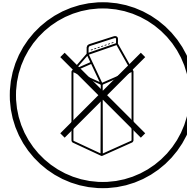

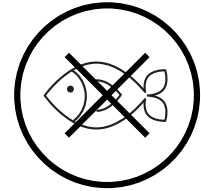

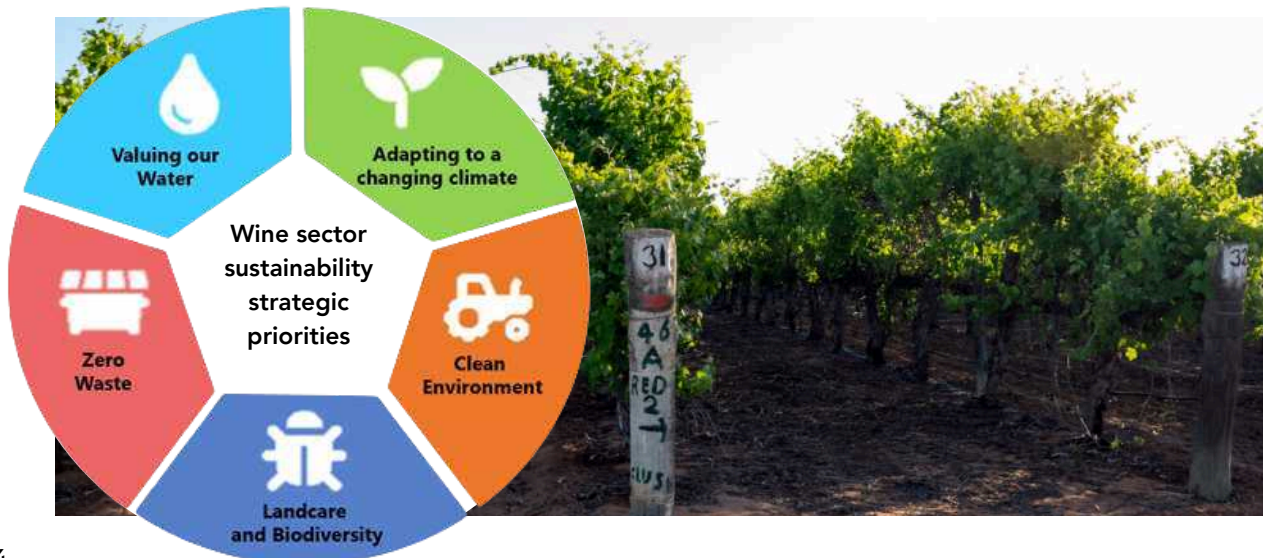


Sustainability

Byrne Vineyards is an advocate of sustainable viticulture and winegrowing practices. Our dedication to this vision drives us to continuously implement and improve sustainability initiatives. We recognise that Australia boasts of an exquisite biodiversity and natural beauty, and we take pride in our role in preserving it for future generations.

Byrne Vineyards are proudly a certified member of Sustainable Winegrowing Australia. Our ethos revolves around minimizing harm and maximizing benefits to the environment and the community. At Byrne Vineyards, sustainability is not just a buzzword, but a way of life that we are proud to champion.

At the heart of our sustainability goals, we are committed to preserving and maintaining the natural environment on our properties, especially the Wetland environment at our Scotts Creek Vineyard, which is home to many rare and endangered species, including over 73 native flora and fauna, and is one of South Australia's largest natural wetland environments. We proudly maintain 12 acres of natural land for every 1 acre of vineyard which we farm. That adds up to over 15 square kilometres of maintained natural lands.



Innovation

Vine Dried

Single vineyard, vine dried Shiraz grapes grown in our estate are the backbone to this intense style. The process of vine dried is when we implement 'deficit irrigation' at the end of the growing season, a few weeks before harvest. This dries out the grapes on the vine, resulting in an intense flavour profile whilst maintaining the vibrancy of the fruit. This technique creates a full-bodied, aromatic wine that finishes long and persistent on the palate.

Double Pass

We take advantage of our naturally rich fruit and create a statement in wine style and flavour. Vine dried grapes are fermented into a concentration of flavour and richness, and regular Shiraz is passed over the vine dried to create the double pass - supple and smooth, finishing with lingering flavours.

Field Blend

Wine made from hand selected, low yielding vines grown in the estate, harvested then co-fermented with minimal intervention. Every vintage, the ratio of varietals is adjusted to enhance the characteristics that showcase that specific day in the vineyard. The fruits flavours develop in synergy during fermentation and produce a naturally harmonious wine.

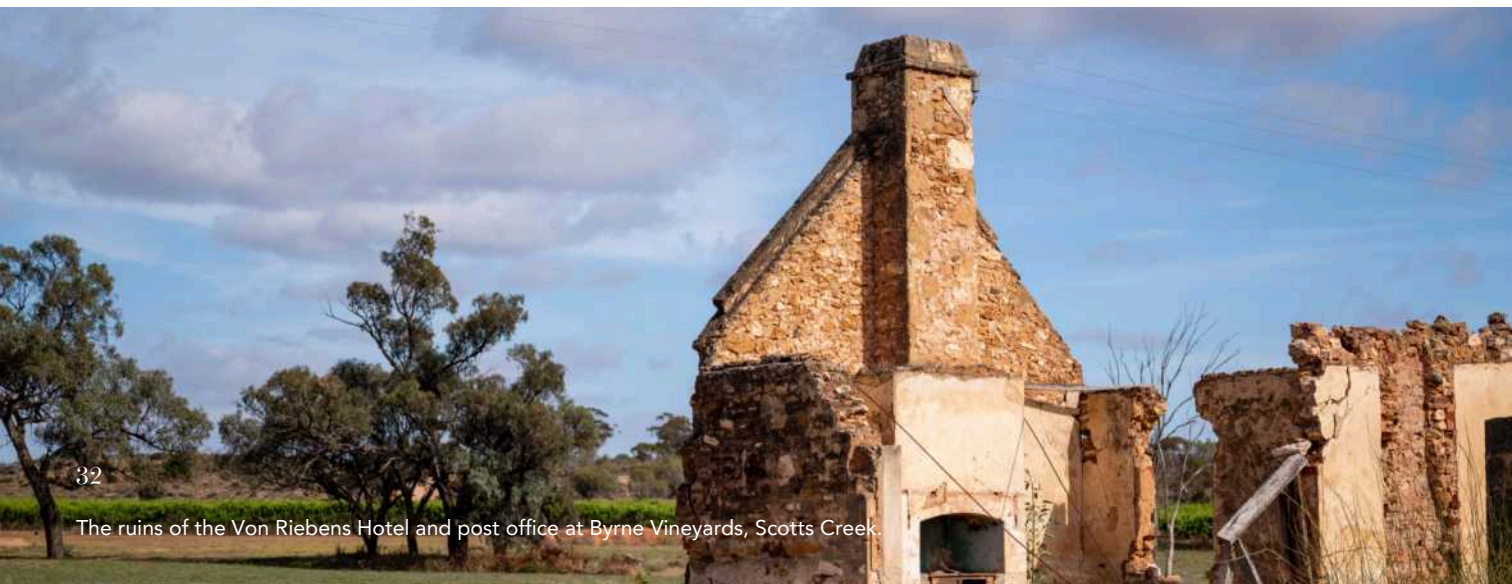

Von Rieben

Baron Hermann Von Rieben emigrated from Mecklenburg to South Australia in 1849. Six years later he built the Von Riebens Hotel on our property, which was a tourist haven for many. Every comfort and accommodation was more than one could expect near the majestic lagoon teeming with fish and bird life.

These sites are a shared link to our history and sit serenely adjacent the vineyards which continue to thrive, producing this estate grown, aromatic wine.
