"One sunny afternoon in Melbourne, I was at a barbeque picnic with friends sipping on some Siskin Chardonnay. Siskin is our other range of fine wines named after the bird, and the label has its image on it. Just as we were enjoying our banter, my attention went to a colourful little bird pecking on the wine label. It was almost as if she was jostling for attention and wanted this rather realistic looking bird out of her arena.

The moment we realised what happened, we burst out into collective laughter, startling the little bird and it fluttered away. I knew that this pretty bird Finch is native to Australia. Inspired by the colourful character of the bird, I went on to craft a range of vibrant, refreshing wines that are truly Australian. As a tribute to the unusual moment that led to the idea, I named the brand Finch. And of course, the label has the bird on it."

Whether the audacious range of Finch wines does justice to this strange true story or not, our wines are certainly an outcome of select grapes from the finest wine regions, and created with passion by our master vintners. Most of our wines are vegan and they graciously break the myth that fantastic wines are hard to find.

SHIRAZ 2020





Sourced from the finest vineyards of South Australia, Finch Shiraz is sassy, bold and insanely delicious. This elegant wine has a medium body, pairs well with most cuisines and is perfect for easy drinking that everyone can enjoy. The Finch Shiraz displays ripe red fruit flavours like fresh plums, cherries, strawberries and raspberries, with hints of cedar, pepper and cinnamon. The soft and velvety tannins set up a long, smooth finish.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017





This rich and complex wine displays notes of dark cherry, blackcurrant, plum and fragrant dusty spices, with hints of chocolate from French and American oak. You would also pick up hints of cassis flavours, cigar box, eucalyptus and cedar, combined with a lingering gamey note. It shows a brick red colour with subtle layers of anise and blackberry flavours. This herbaceous Cabernet Sauvignon has great length, with a lingering smooth finish owing to the soft and well-structured tannins.

PINOT NOIR 2021





This aromatic Pinot is a melange of herbal flavours. With an almost translucent bright red look, notes of young strawberry, dark cherry, raspberry, chamomile and vanilla hit the nose first. The first sip would feel spicy, and you would pick up on notes of well-integrated savoury oak. Plush flavours of plum, violet flowers and honeysuckle linger with a faint hint of forest floor on the palate, well supported by tannins. The bright fruity and juicy acidity of this Pinot Noir leads to a fine chalky finish.

CHARDONNAY





Aromas of citrus and stone fruits like peach and nectarine, with hints of floral notes introduce this intense fruit-driven Chardonnay. Holding it up to the light, you can see that the pale gold colour seems to sparkle. The first sip has hints of fresh green apple, and almost immediately the vanilla flavour kicks in thanks to the french oak. With a medium body, creamy texture and dry profile, the palate has a crisp and refreshing finish.

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2022





This refreshing Sauvignon Blanc displays fruit-forward flavours of white peach, melon, pear, gooseberry and orange zest. You would also pick up on hints of grapefruit, passion fruit, lime and kiwi. This light bodied wine is extremely soft on the palate and has very little sulphur on the nose. With fine herbal and tropical fruit notes, this dry, acidic wine concludes to a crisp and refreshing citrusy finish.

ROSE 2022





This Rose displays highly perfumed aromatics - notes of watermelon, berries, orange, acacia, camomile and jasmine blossom with a touch of white pepper. The nose is full of fresh candied notes from the grapes that are lightly pressed, extracting just enough colour to deliver that classic pale pink. This Rose allows the delicate fruit characters and Cool Climate minerality to hop across your palate for an everlasting finish.
