About Us:

Sister's Run is serious fun. Our talented young winemaker Elena wears steel cap work boots every day of course, but carries a pair of high heels in back of the ute, only for emergencies, like last minute invitations to accept trophies at gala wine show dinners and the like

Returning from a 'knees-up' at midnight, mid vintage, she managed to kick off one high heel and slip back into a boot' just as the cellar crew cried out, 'Run Sister Run'; and exactly then our winemaker and label took flight!

The stiletto and boot are Sister's Run; an independently owned and operated winery with a fierce commitment to making the best wines we can from family vineyards. We don't take ourselves as seriously as we take our wines, but agree with Elena, all you need to know about wine is the five 'V's and remember the best wine is the wine you like.

Colour:

Pale yet starbright; the faintest hue of white hay at dawn.

Nose:

Pure riesling aromatics that so define its sense of place and time: marzipan, honeydew, banana skin, citrus zest, fresh green herbs. This is a fresh and full and alive white wine that has as much an olfactory sensation as it does an aromatic lift.

Palate:

Ripe citrus fruits dominate the entire palate and make for the silky yet searing mouthfeel. Acidic purrs along the length of flavours, keeping the lemon and lime accents all too pert and refreshingly upright. A long, long finish, with that understatedly yet perfectly ripe citrus fruit flavour persisting.

Serve with:

This white wine needs only two observations: i) have at least two bottles chilled well; ii) have at least six people chilled well. 11am and a few plates of Dead Things On Toast and before you know what has happened to the death of civility you will all want luncheon. And this wine will have done its job.
