



The Prosecco grape has its origins on the cool slopes of the Veneto region of North East Italy. Taking inspiration from their Italian heritage, the grapes for Redbank Prosecco are grown on small family owned vineyards at Whitfield and Myrrhee in the heart of North Eastern Victoria's alpine region.

WINEMAKING

All aspects of winemaking are focussed on maintaining a refreshing, crisp sparkling wine with delicate flavour. The grapes are harvested and pressed on a gentle cycle to minimisephenolics and then fermented to produce a classic base wine. After blending and ageing on yeast lees, the final blend is tank fermented and expedition liqueur is added.

TASTING NOTE

Sourced from our high-altitude vineyards in the King Valley. This dry and fresh Sparkling has hints of pear, honeycomb and granny smith apples. The palate is subtly sweet finely balanced by natural acidity, typical chalky texture and a light savoury finish. Enjoy anytime with friends and food.
