TASTING NOTES

Sourced from the subregions of Polish Hill River and Armagh and matured for 18 months in 30% new French oak.

The bouquet shows powerful blackberry and dark jube fruits with complexity. On the palate the flavours are intense and concentrated, balanced with beautiful acidity and long fine grained tannin.

This wine will cellar well over the next 8/10 years.
