



Our Story

The Moss Brothers name has been synonymous with high quality Margaret River wines for more than 30 years. Originally established by viticulturist Jeff Moss at Wilyabrup in 1984, the brand focussed on Semillon Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Cabernets and Merlot.

Roll forward thirty five years and the Moss Brothers brand remains central to profiling the Margaret River wine region. Our all consuming aim is to capture the essence of the Margaret River whilst also exploring the single vineyard expression of our flagship vineyard just outside Margaret River township.

The Margaret River Wine Region first saw European settlement as late as the early 1830's. It has evolved from a

pioneer 'outstation' to forestry, dairy and alternative life stylers who enjoyed the unique coast and its surfing to an area dedicated to the pursuit of great vines and fine wines.

The Region

Margaret River is embraced by the ocean on three sides and the resulting maritime influence lends itself to ideal growing conditions for wine grapes. One of, if not the most isolated and pure grape growing regions in the world, its maritime climate provides natural assistance from the wind, rain and sun at mostly the right time of year. Its weather travels 1,000 kilometres across open ocean to reach Margaret River (Africa is 8,500 kilometres and the South Pole 5,000 kilometres away) which ensures it is

free and distant from polluting winds and rain.

The Wines

Our wines are powerful, approachable and expressive. Every wine is a reflection of the uniqueness of place and personality that comprises the entirety of the Margaret River wine region producing uniquely blended and vitalising Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon, generously textured Chardonnay and powerful and elegant Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz wines. In addition, our Western Australian wines started life in the vineyards of some of the world's most committed artisan vignerons. They are a wonderful blend of the diverse regions of Western Australia that our winemaker has, in turn, crafted into

wines that are a true expression of both variety and place. Wines that are an exciting reflection of the vineyards from which they came. Powerful wines with elegance, flavour and style.

Rory is the senior winemaker at Moss Brothers, and he comes with a wealth of industry experience, including a recent role working for Frank Tate within which he was responsible for producing a broad cross range of wines on a commercial scale of over 500,000 cases.

Rory always had an interest in Agriculture. After working in the vineyard during a summer holidays, he decided to pursue Viticulture and Oenology. The science of winemaking got him hooked, loving the way it combined agriculture with science and art.

His favourite varietals are Cabernet, Shiraz, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, as they are the varietals he's had the most experience with and the most widely produced in Margaret River. With a goal to further his studies and knowledge, to keep growing as a winemaker and Win the Jimmy Watson!, Rory is set to become one of our team's biggest assets.

Our Moss Brothers wines are a very considered and practised combination of quality fruit drawn from some of West Australia's most respected wine growers.

West Australian vineyards are strongly influenced by their maritime exposures. The Indian and Southern Oceans ensure rainfall is plentiful and even during the warmer Australian summers, daytime temperatures are mediated by cooling evening sea breezes. The warm days and cool nights deliver a long even ripening period where acidity is retained, and flavour developed to allow full expression of the varietal flavours and aromas. This is what is required to produce complex wines with drive and depth.

aylesbury estate

The Aylesbury Estate story is steeped in history. The Estate is named after the town of Aylesbury from which the Gibbs family hailed. The Gibbs family moved to the Ferguson Valley in 1883, over 140 years ago. The 22 acre vineyard is a part of a family owned farm that has been passed down through 5 generations of the Gibbs Family.

PROUD HERITAGE

Ryan Gibbs took over the ownership and management of the farm in 2008. Ryan, along with his wife Narelle, established the Aylesbury Estate label with the intention of "capturing the best of the Ferguson Valley in a bottle."

PRISTINE ENVIRONMENT

The Ferguson Valley climate is similar to south-west Europe and the Mediterranean, with cool wet winters and warm dry summers, perfect for grape-growing. The west coast of Australia is subject to prevailing sea-breezes and the influence of reliable rainfall from winter cold-front weather systems. This is somewhat similar to the west coast of France and particularly the Bordeaux region. For this reason we chose to plant Bordeaux varieties and we believe they thrive in our conditions.

The property is 200 hectares (500 acres) in total with approximately 9 hectares (22 acres) under vine. The elevation of 160 to 220 meters above sea

level enables the cooling sea breezes to reach the vineyard from the Indian Ocean. North-facing slopes were chosen as the best sites for Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Sauvignon Blanc.

The soil types of the property are fertile rich chocolate loam with underlying clay, helping to retain moisture for the vines. The native Australian forests surrounding the property provide pure, clean water for our vines throughout summer.





Ironcloud Estate is situated in the picturesque Ferguson Valley, in the hills of the Geographe Wine Region. We are located 20 minutes inland from the city of Bunbury, 2 hours south of Perth and 1 hour north of Margaret River.

Three lifelong friends and business partners, Warwick Lavis, Geoff and Karyn Cross strengthened their alliance in 2003 with the purchase of a vineyard which is now named Ironcloud.


Our Estate comprises of a single vineyard with 28 acres under vine comprising hand-tended Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvedre, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Viognier.

Our vines were planted in 1999 in highly prized red gravelly loam soils. The vines were planted north to south on gently sloping hillsides to optimise growing conditions.

At Ironcloud we aim to produce wines that capture a unique sense of terroir in every bottle and draw inspiration from the great wines of the world. Our winemaking philosophy is to make the best wines from the best grapes.

In its short history, Ironcloud has won numerous Australian and International awards and received strong praise from respected Australian wine writers.

After laying strong foundations in our first decade, the next decade is shaping up as a transformational one. We're excited and look forward to sharing the experience with you.

Our family-owned and operated vineyard is located in Wilyabrup, the heart of the Margaret River wine region. Although this is a relatively small region, 20% of Australia's premium wines originate from here. With the area's perfect combination of the right soil and supreme climate, Jilyara has the terroir to grow fruit of outstanding quality.

The vineyard was planted in 1996 by the Cotterell family. With a north-south aspect and nestled within undulating valleys, it is protected from the elements behind a nature reserve, yet near enough to the ocean to hear the surf. In our nine hectare vineyard, we grow predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon, but also Malbec, Petit Verdot, Merlot and Sauvignon Blanc. After having produced grapes for over twenty-three years supplying

some of the area's prime producers, we're now embarking on an exciting venture in producing our own wine.

To produce the best possible fruit, we hand prune and pick our grapes with care. We shoot thin, leaf pluck and trim to ensure adequate air flow and light to provide a healthy microclimate and to minimise the use of fungicidal sprays. Craig Cotterell, the owner-operator, does all of the spraying, netting, and mulching himself, and by using minimal contractor equipment he ensures a sound and disease free vineyard. Tillage and soil compaction is kept to a minimum, and our sheep graze the vineyard post-harvest promoting natural weed suppression. Craig has managed every aspect of the vineyard since the beginning and strives to grow grapes of superior quality.

Our hands-on approach guarantees the viticultural practices are closely monitored.

Jilyara is also home to the Cotterell family, a playground for their children and a space where they indulge in their passion for exceptional wine every day. Craig, and his partner in crime Maria, along with their four children are all an integral part of the vineyard. 'We feel truly lucky to be custodians of such a special piece of land'.





WHY THE BEE?

The name 'Jilyara' was inspired by the abundance of bees in the vineyard and derives from 'Djilyaro', meaning 'bees' in the local indigenous Noongar language. Bees have always been essential to the production of great wines. Though not necessary to aid the vines with pollination, bees help maintain a healthy ecosystem within the vineyard. We've equipped Jilyara with four beehives, one at each corner of our property – our own honeycomb corners, helping to keep our crops fertile and healthy.

WILYABRUP REGION

Wilyabrup is recognised as one of the world's great wine regions and is only a scenic three hour drive south of Perth in Western Australia. It is one of the six sub-regions that were identified by Dr Gladstone, who was the first to recognise the potential of Margaret River as an ideal wine growing region. The climate combines perfectly with the ancient gravelly soils and despite being one of the smallest sub-regions of the total 5,017 hectares (12,397 acres) of the Margaret River wine region – 1 of 5 premium wines originate from here.

Far away from polluting winds and rain and surrounded by ocean on three sides, the maritime influenced climate has often been compared to the famous region of Bordeaux in France in having

ideal conditions for growing vines. The rolling surf can be heard while working in the vineyard, and being so close to the Indian Ocean ensures not only reliable rainfall, but means there is no worry of extremes such as frost, or excessive heat.



THE WILLIAMS' BLOCK



The Williams' Block is a block of special significance within our vineyard. Passed down from generation to generation, all the men in our family hold this name. This tradition continues with our three sons, who we are lucky enough to be raising on our estate in Wilyabrup, Margaret River. Only select parcels of exceptional fruit are chosen each vintage to make our 'Williams' Block' Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon, two iconic varieties of the Margaret River wine region, holding a name that honours the tradition of our family.


















A genuine love of the Margaret River wine region is where the story begins. The Child's family, founders of Knee Deep, broke ground back in 2000 establishing what was to become an iconic Margaret River winery. To the Child's family Knee Deep was a tongue-in-cheek acknowledgement of jumping in 'boots and all' during a testing time in the wine industry with the grape glut of the late nineties, but times have changed and so too have the reigns.

These reigns have now passed onto the Holden family. Matt & Clair Holden have worked alongside Phil & Sue Child's for over 5 years, so when Phil & Sue decided to hang up their wine boots Matt & Clair stepped in, not wanting to see an iconic Margaret River story come to an end. In the tradition of jumping in "Knee Deep" a new era begins, being knee deep in the fruit is where it all starts, but also being knee deep in the Margaret River world of wine.

Matt has been immersed in the West Australian wine industry for over 20 years. Transitioning from the hospitality industry, running top venues in Canada, Scotland

and Perth, to working some of Margaret River's most respected producers on the production and sales side. Matt & Clair's passion for West Australian wine has led them to continue the Knee Deep story. Taking over the Knee Deep reigns is yet another chapter in their story, keeping Knee Deep as a family owned, West Australian owned business, and as a legacy to their three children.

Nestled in the pristine southwest corner of Western Australia, Margaret River has in under 50 years grown to become one of the world's great wine producing regions, producing over 20% of Australia's premium wine. Stretching almost 100 kilometres from north to south the region holds a diversity truly unique and unlike any other wine region, largely untouched by large scale human interference. It is hugged by ocean on three sides, the cooling sea breezes temper the summer heat, protecting the vines from temperature extremes. This maritime influence provides a consistent climate, which is perfect for the region's more elegant and subtle styles of wines.

Matt & Clair met in 1993, both first year university students. Over the past 25 years they have travelled the world, renovated their family home (three times) and have had three beautiful yet crazy children. Knee Deep is Matt & Clair's next chapter, a very exciting chapter. Matt's passion for photography was overtaken by his passion for wine in his early twenties. After completing a

Bachelor of Arts in Photo Media he hung up his camera to taste his way through many tasting panels. Matt has 25 years' experience in the booze industry, managing top hospitality venues all around the world, eventually settling back in Perth he went on to work in the wine sales and production industry for 10 years deciding to go out in his own business in 2013. Fresh from completing her Bachelor of Arts in Marketing and Media Clair took a sales role with Peters & Brownes, WA's leading supplier of dairy and ice cream products. Over 13 years she excelled in many roles including Channel Management, Trade Marketing & Sales Management. In August 2013 Clair took the plunge and resigned from Brownes to join the family business. Clair now splits her time between running all marketing and sales support and looking after three young children, often both roles at the same time.





Knee Deep in Margaret River

THE ESTATE



HISTORY

IN THE 1900S CATTLE ON THE COASTAL PLAINS NEAR BUSSELTON WERE ALLOWED TO ROAM FREE IN THE HIGHER FOREST COUNTRY IN SEARCH OF FEED ONCE THE LOCAL PADDOCKS HAD DRIED UP. THEY WERE CONSTANTLY FOUND TO FAVOUR THE SWEET GRASSES OF THE GRANITE COUNTRY AND SO THIS LOCATION WAS ONE OF THE FIRST IN THE REGION TO BE TAKEN UP FOR AGRICULTURE AT THE TURN OF THE 20TH CENTURY. IT IS STILL TODAY CONSIDERED BY LOCAL FARMERS OF THE DISTRICT TO BE PRIME PRODUCTION LAND.

THE PROPERTY WAS STILL FARMED BY THE DESCENDANTS OF THE ORIGINAL SETTLING FAMILY WHEN IT WAS PURCHASED BY MARK AND ALISON BLIZARD IN 1998 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A VINEYARD.

IN PRIDE OF PLACE OVERLOOKING THE ENTIRE PROPERTY STANDS A SOLID JARRAH

FIRE TOWER ERECTED IN THE 1960S BY THE THEN FORESTRY DEPARTMENT. AS THIS LAND IS AMONGST THE HIGHEST IN THE REGION, THE TOWER WAS ONCE A VITAL LINK IN THE DEPARTMENT'S FIRE CONTROL OPERATIONS. TODAY MORE SOPHISTICATED METHODS HAVE SEEN THE TOWER GO OUT OF SERVICE BUT IT STILL STANDS AS A TESTAMENT TO THE PROPERTY'S PROMINENT POSITION IN THE LANDSCAPE.


THE VINEYARI



THE ESTATE

A passionate farmer, P.Y Peos originally began cultivating grapes and producing wine whilst in his birth country of Macedonia almost a century ago. He passed his love of wine down to his son, Jim, who continued to plant grapes and produce wine in Macedonia until he emigrated with some of his family to Australia in 1951.

Upon arrival in Western Australia, the Peos family settled in Manjimup, attracted by its rich soils and ideal crop-growing climate. Their devotion to the land has seen them farm almost everything from dairy cattle and beef to mixed horticulture, potatoes, cauliflowers and beans.

Peos Estate is nestled in this boutique region in one of the most remote wine districts in the world and is home to some of the earth's oldest soils. This combined with the region's elevation, pristine water and cool temperatures, means Manjimup is perfectly poised to consistently produce world-class wines.

With viticulture in their veins, brothers Vic, John, Kon and Chris banded together in 1996 to create their dream vineyard as a legacy to their late father, Jim Peos, and late grandfather, P.Y Peos. The Peos portfolio is produced entirely from estate grown grapes, harvested from the vines planted on the 90 acre property. The establishment of Peos Estate winery by the third generation Peos brothers has spun the family dynasty full-circle back to where it belongs, growing grapes and producing award winning wines.

GENUINELY SOUTHERN FORESTS

The rise in industrial-scale agriculture and globally sourced food means our society has never been more removed from how and where our food is produced. Even 'Made in Australia' is no guarantee that a bottle of juice or loaf of bread hasn't been made from imported ingredients.

A passionate group of growers and producers in the Southern Forests region of Western Australia believe consumers have the right to genuinely know where their food comes from. They have created the 'Genuinely Southern Forests' logo to clearly identify all produce from Manjimup, Pemberton, Northcliffe and Walpole.

Genuinely Southern Forests is more than a logo. It is a tool to help consumers make a genuinely informed decision about what they put in their body.

Our 2018 'Suits' is a beautifully complex wine, crafted by selecting the best 2018 barrels of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon, grown in single vineyards on our Manjimup estate. Deep purple in colour, with spiced raspberry, cherry liquor and notes of dried savoury herbs. Intense flavours of mulberry, blackberries and dark chocolate are carried by supple tannins to a bright finish with lingering spiced toffee notes.

THIS RANGE OF WINES IS NAMED AFTER THE FOUR MAGNIFICENT KARRI TREES WHICH ARE NEARLY 75 METERS TALL AND OVER 400 YEARS OLD AND ARE LOCATED DOWN THE ROAD FROM OUR WINERY IN MANJIMUP.

This range of wines is named after the four magnificent Karri trees which are nearly 75 meters tall and over 400 years old and are located down the road from our winery in Manjimup. The Karri tree is one of the largest living things on our planet. One tree can weigh over 200 tonnes, grow to 90m in height, take nine people holding hands to span its girth, and do it all in 400 years. Nestled amongst the tranquil tall timbers the Peos vineyard's gravelly soil is ideally suited to crafting premium wines, and with the Peos family having tilled those soils for over half a century we believe this is a fitting moniker for flagship range.







WITH VITICULTURE IN THEIR HISTORICAL VEINS, BROTHERS VIC, JOHN, KON AND CHRIS BANDED TOGETHER IN 1996 TO CREATE THEIR DREAM VINEYARD AS A LEGACY TO THEIR LATE FATHER, JIM PEOS, AND LATE GRANDFATHER, PY PEOS. THE FOUR KINGS RANGE IS NAMED AFTER THE FOUR PEOS BROTHERS.

The Four Kings range is named after the four Peos brothers. The Peos brothers work hard to keep family traditions alive and ensure Peos Estate follows the customs that were passed down by their late father and grandfather. One of these traditions is the philosophy of minimal intervention which allows the wine to be produced in the most natural way. This ensures the regional and varietal characters of the grapes are captured and retained in all Peos wines.








FOUR JACKS

The young Peos family will continue to follow the family winemaking traditions, however, will look to position this range as a more modern and contemporary offering that appeals to their generation of wine drinkers and beyond.













OUR STORY

Whicher Ridge is the result of 12 years of hands-on work by the dynamic duo of Neil and Cathy Howard, a vigneron and winemaker couple with a combined 50 years of experience between them. They have a very 'a hands-on' approach to growing their grapes and making their wines, and a 'tread lightly on the earth' philosophy with their sustainable farming practices. They craft small batch, single vineyard wines which are full of varietal and terroir specific flavours, from vines grown in the ancient soils of three of Australia's most isolated wine regions in the South West of Western Australia. Their wines are made in styles which not only celebrate their provenance but are wines which have been specifically crafted to pair well with food, having texture, flavour intensity, length and balance.

OUR PHILOSOPHY

"Our grape growing philosophy is to use sustainable biological management practices in our vineyard. We use a minimal spray application programme to prevent disease, and we do not use pesticides. Under-vine grasses and flowering plants are retained providing habitats that encourage predatory insects and insect diversity throughout our vineyard. We compost our winery and garden waste, and use this compost in our vineyard and in our gardens.


Our winemaking philosophy is to use hands-on, traditional artisanal winemaking techniques and minimal additions in the winery. We utilise extended yeast lees contact with all of our white wines and the additives that we do use are all natural. The way we manage our red ferments is very labour intensive, but the results in terms of col-our and flavour intensity are well worth the hard work. Our red wines are fermented in open topped fermenters, with a portion also fermenting in barrels to add extra complexity. We utilise a traditional basket press for pressing off our red ferments once they are dry".

OUR VINEYARDS

For us, it all comes back to terroir, the French concept that encompasses everything to do with growing a grapevine, the soil, the micro climate and the aspect of the land, as well as how the grape vine is trained and nurtured. The terroir has a major influence on the flavours, style and structure of the final wine made from those grapes. So, it's vitally important to match the grape variety with the ideal terroir for that variety. Get this match right, and the wine that you make is of the highest quality possible.

Some of our grape varieties we grow ourselves in our Whicher Ridge and Tapalinga vineyards, and others we source from grape growers with whom we have a close working relationship, who share the same passion and dedication to growing quality grapes as we do. The end result for us is that we grow and source the grapes for our wines from three wine regions in Western Australia, spread across the wine regions of Margaret River, Geographe and the Great Southern.

The lightning bolt on the label and on our logo is about our ESP, our Energy, Strength and and Power.

The lightning bolt striking the ridge is symbolic of our energy that has gone into developing and nurturing our vineyard to produce grapes of the very highest quality, and the energy that goes into the making of our wines. The strength and power of the lightning bolt also represents our unique partnership of an experienced viticulturalist and a highly skilled winemaker, with an enduring passion for what we do, and why we do it.

Whitetail Sparkling Chardonnay is a blanc de blanc style and has been named after the flocks of endangered Whitetail black cockatoos that regularly visit our farm.

The colour is medium to light-yellow and it has persistent mousse of bubbles. Aromas of lemon, granny smith apple, cashew nut and brioche, with hints of toast from development in the bottle. It's soft and fruity, mouthfilling and rich on the palate, with a well-judged liqueur level and great drinkability. As it warms in the glass, some lovely honeyed complexities show through.

A blanc de blanc sparkling made from chardonnay. The secondary ferment occurs in the bottle, which is when the magic happens and those glorious fine beads of bubbles are created.


