VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A dry yet cooler vintage, 2019 has delivered smaller yields of highly-flavoured fruit. The lower than average rainfall between December and harvest created a few challenges, but through careful fruit selection and final blending, this classic final cuvée really shows what the Clare Valley can deliver.

WINEMAKING

Our Killerman's Run Cabernet Sauvignon has been crafted through careful fruit selection, traditional winemaking techniques, sixteen months maturation in new and seasoned French oak hogsheads and bottling unfiltered to fully enhance the wines character and appeal.

COLOUR

Brick red in colour with deep crimson hues.

NOSE

Redolent of cassis and tobacco leaf with a subtle charré French oak character.

PALATE

The aromas are mimicked on the palate where they are supported by fine grained tannins, smoky oak and balanced acidity. The long, succulent finish will give rise to further complexity if cellared carefully.
