The Wine A stand-out single vineyard, Cabernet Sauvignon straight from the 'forgotten' wine region of Coonawarra. In true RedHeads style, we have rescued a parcel of grapes from being blended away to make a premium cabernet.

Sick of being tied to big brands, the grower was exceptionally keen to sell us these grapes as they knew that we would give the grapes the attention they deserve which is why we're always in the Catbird Seat!

Machine harvested in the afternoon to avoid the morning dews in the Coonawarra. De-stemmed and partially fermented in a French oak wooden Vat for 14 days.

The growers The grapes comes from a close friend - RedHeads Movement Member - Jack Burston.

The exceptional fruits were planted under the guidance of the late Wayne Stehbens, the prodigy winemaker of 40 years at the award-winning winery Katnook. Only the best grapes for a RedHead wine.

Ageing 12 maturation in French and American Oak barrels.
