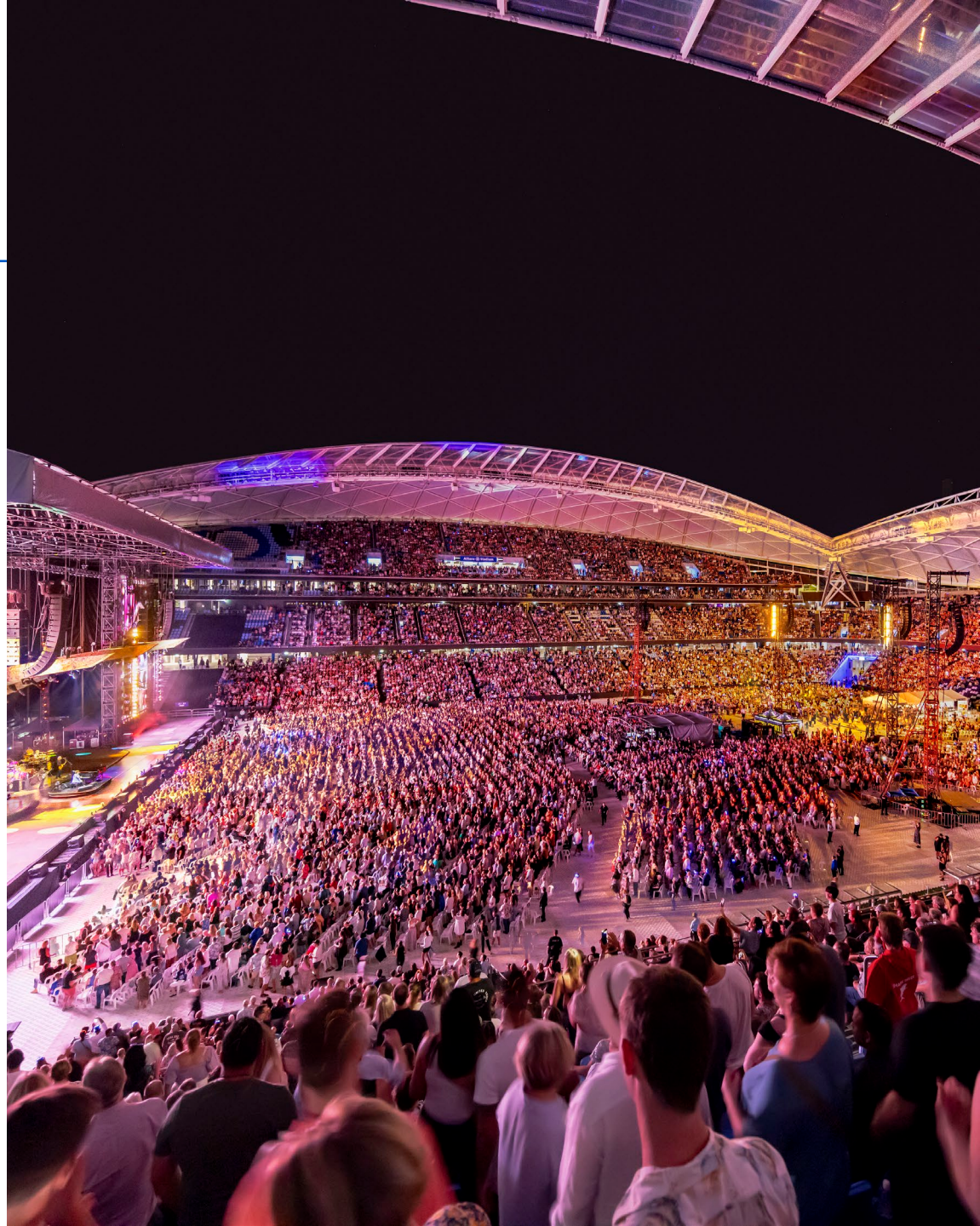
Sunday 15 November 2026

- 30,000+ crowd
- Bump-in commences 10th November (truck movements and stage build)

Future

Possible Allianz Stadium concert March 2027

- One night with option for two.
- Confirmation in next two months



Rideshare & Geofencing

- The Moore Park bubble is operational on event days
- Coloured lines on the map indicate the drop-off and pick-up zones as directed by the rideshare apps.
- In operation for NRL Anzac Day Cup
- Doesn't fully capture taxis, which can line up in rideshare/other lanes and block traffic



Moore Park Rd cycleway extension

- Paddington Lane is the main entry point for vehicle access to the SCG and, currently, Allianz Stadium.
- Dozens of vehicle movements per day from passenger vehicles to large semi-trailers.
- Consistent feedback about cycleway crossover with the stadiums' major vehicle access point.
- Cyclists often ignore Regent St-MP Rd lights/stop signal, increasing collision risk.
- At least one injury to a cyclist, as well as multiple near misses – not recorded in Council documents.
- Cycleway is closed during events. This would continue to limit risk when traffic and pedestrian movements all peak.



eBikes in the precinct

- Providers (Lime, Ario, Hello Bike) drop bikes in the precinct - often not on Venues NSW land.
- Similarly, where riders park them is uncontrolled.
- Bikes are often moved on before and during event days as they can obstruct footpaths, accessible routes, entry paths and exits.
- Investigating with providers & precinct partners to establish a bubble that would see bikes in designated safe parking areas on event days.
