CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Conditions of Entry for the Newcastle Entertainment Centre apply upon entry to the Carpark. These are available here www.nec.net.au/conditions_of_entry

CONDITIONS OF PARKING

By entering and remaining in this Carpark for longer than 10 minutes, you agree to the following terms and conditions. If you do not accept these conditions, you must immediately exit the Carpark.

ENTRY AT YOUR OWN RISK

Any person entering this Carpark does so entirely at their own risk. To the furthest extent permitted by law, the Owner and Operator accept no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to any vehicle or property, or for injury to any person, however caused. All liability is excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law. You are responsible for your vehicle or property upon entry.

OBEY ALL SIGNS AND DIRECTIONS

You must comply with all signage and any lawful directions given by the Operator. You may only park in spaces designated by the Operator. You must observe all rules, ordinances and guidelines of the car park. Designations for accessibility and other special requirements must be observed.

OPERATOR RIGHTS

The Operator may, at any time and without notice or reason:

- Refuse entry or revoke your permit to enter or park
- Lawfully enter any vehicle using any means necessary
- Lawfully move or drive any vehicle within the Carpark
- Lawfully remove any vehicle considered unsafe, obstructive, abandoned or a nuisance
- Lawfully remove any vehicle if the driver is in breach of these terms.

CUSTOMER WARRANTY AND INDEMNITY

You warrant that you are the titleholder (lawful owner) of the vehicle or have the authority from the titleholder. To the furthest extent permitted by law, you indemnify the Owner and Operator against any and all claims, actions, losses, damages, costs, and expenses arising from or connected with your use of the Carpark.

CCTV MONITORING

This Carpark may be monitored by CCTV for safety, security, and operational purposes. By entering the Carpark, you consent to such monitoring.

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

The following activities are not permitted:



- loitering or sleeping in vehicles
- alcohol consumption or illicit drug use
- skateboarding, cycling, or similar activities
- unauthorised commercial activity or solicitation

SAFE DRIVING AND SPEED LIMITS

You must drive safely and obey the posted speed limit at all times.

UNAUTHORISED PARKING AND TOWING

Vehicles parked illegally, dangerously, or in breach of these conditions may be towed or immobilised at your expense.

NO VEHICLE STORAGE

This Carpark is for short-term parking only. Long-term or abandoned vehicle storage is prohibited.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Accessible bays may only be used when a valid permit is displayed.

SEVERABILITY

If any part of these conditions is illegal or unenforceable, that part may be severed to the extent necessary. The remainder will continue in full force and effect.

STATUTORY RIGHTS

These conditions are subject to non-excludable rights under Australian Consumer Laws.
