

# NORTHERN METROPOLITAN REGION PRIMARY BOYS/MIXED & GIRLS NETBALL FINALS



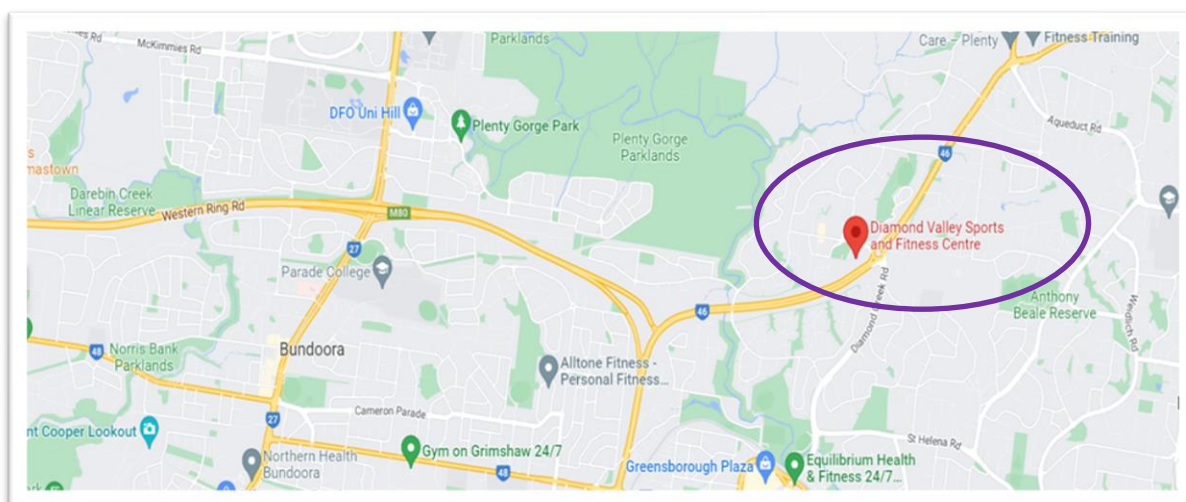

## COMPETITION STRUCTURE

- A preliminary round-robin stage will consist of 2 pools of 3 schools- each school will play **two pool matches**.
- **Cross over semi-finals** for teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in their respective pools (see fixture below. )
- Winners of each semi-final will qualify for the **Grand Final**.
- Losers of each semi-final will qualify for the **3<sup>rd</sup> place playoff**.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place from each pool will qualify for the **5<sup>th</sup> place playoff**.
- At the end of each Round Robin game, 4 points will be awarded for a win, 2 points for a draw and 0 points for a loss.
- If, at the end of the round robin, two teams are equal on points, then the winner of the face to face match will be declared the winner. If their face to face match was a draw, then total percentage from all their games will be used to determine the winner. If more than two teams are tied on points, percentage from the matches involving the other tied teams will be calculated to determine the winner.
- In the event of a draw being played in the semi-final & final, the game shall be decided by playing two, five minute halves with a one minute interval until a winner is determined.

## TEAM SHEETS

- **A completed team sheet** (endorsed by the school's principal or their representative) must be submitted **via email** to the NMR Primary Coordinator via email ([Heath.Yasunaga@education.vic.gov.au](mailto:Heath.Yasunaga@education.vic.gov.au)) **no later than the day before the event, or a hard copy handed to the convenor before commencement of play**. If not provided, the teacher/coach will need to complete a team sheet manually prior to their team being able to play. With team sheets, we only require students first name, initial of their surname and year level.

## MATCH CONDITIONS & RULES

### **Match duration:**

- All matches shall consist of 2 x 12 minute halves with a 2 minute interval at half time.

### **Rules:**

- Netball is conducted under the rules of the All Australian Netball Association unless otherwise stated.
- Any infringements under section 13 Game Management, Rule 13.2 Foul Play will see the umpire apply the Rule 13.1 Actions Taken by an Umpire.
- The Team Coach/Teacher accompanying the team MUST be informed when these actions are taken.
- Please see the [SSV Primary Schools Resource Manual](#) for more useful sport specific information.

### **Living through Respect:**

- All players, teachers, spectators and officials are bound by the '[SSV Codes of Conduct](#)' and the '[Participant Behaviour Policy](#)'.

### **Team make up:**

- A maximum of twelve (12) players may be used in one day.
- Seven (7) players on the court and up to five (5) interchange players are to be named for each game.
- **A Boys/Mixed Team** must be made up of a minimum of one Boy who is on the court for the entire game. A team that cannot field a minimum of one Boy in every game does not meet the Conditions of Competition and will be ineligible to receive points or awards and will not progress to the next level of competition.
- A girl cannot play in a girls team and a boys/mixed team in the same sport.
- The level of competition chosen by a student at District level remains binding through to Division, Region and State levels.
- **Team sheets are reviewed by the event convenor, and Region Coordinator.** Teams to be found in breach of this rule may face consequences, including disqualification.

### **Safety:**

- Goal post padding is required for all netball goal posts for all levels of matches.
- Ensure court is safe to play on through observation before the game e.g. no water spills.

### **Injuries:**

- Injury time allowed is two minutes.
- An injured player may come off and come on again later, at a break in play, if the player has not been replaced. If the injured player has been replaced, the player can come on again during an interval or another injury time out.
- Where central timing is used, a player with the blood rule is to be removed and substituted immediately and can be resubstituted at the next appropriate whistle.

### **Interchange:**

- Rolling substitutions during a game & the interchange of players are permitted at the interval. Teams should have two sets of bibs to facilitate rolling substitutions. Rolling substitutions must occur in the designated area. Only one (1) rolling substitute per team can be made at a time. However, it is required that these players must be ready to take the court so that no time is lost.

## DRESS

- Players must wear same colour skirts/tights/bodysuits/shorts (without pockets) and same colour tops with contrasting bibs.
- Fingernails should be taped or cut.
- No visible jewellery can be worn.
- Players not correctly dressed will not be permitted to compete.

## EQUIPMENT AND OFFICIALS

All schools/teams participating in the NMR Boys/Mixed & Girls Netball Finals will need to provide:

- **1x Size 5 Netball** in match condition.
- **Warm up balls** (if schools choose too)
- Positional bibs. To avoid a clash of colours & to facilitate rolling substitutions, schools are asked to bring a second set of bibs.
- **1x competent scorer.**
- A teacher to coach the team or supervise the team if a non-teacher is coaching the team.
- Score sheets for all matches (and for possible finals, etc.)
- 1x first aid kit (and any asthma/EpiPen's as required)
- **Umpires** will be provided by PESS.
- **Canteen facilities** will be available at the venue.

## FIRST AID

- First Aid will be provided by **PESS**.
- Schools must bring their own first aid kits for bus travel and to further support first aid on the day. Schools must bring their own ice packs to the event.
- If required, schools must bring their own EpiPen's and asthma kits to the event. Schools are responsible for their own student's anaphylaxis and asthma equipment and cannot rely on event first aid resources for these instances.
- Any strapping or taping requirements will be the players responsibility to have complete prior to game time. There will be no provisions for strapping and/or taping from event management.

## STATE FINALS INFORMATION

- The winners of the Grand Finals will be awarded the Champions pennant and qualify as the NMR representative at the [State Championships](#).
