VINIFICATION & WINEMAKING

The 2022 vintage in Clare Valley gave exceptional conditions where the average February ripening temperatures were relatively cool, which led to an elevation in varietal characters. The Calcannia vineyard boasts sandy loam over alluvial clay, enriched with sedimentary rocks, ensuring optimal drainage and providing essential minerals for vine growth. The grapes showcase richness and a muscular fleshy character, embodying a luscious palate length. Following the harvest of nine tones of fruit, fermentation took place in an open concrete fermenter, then matured for 15 months in French and American oak hogs heads to add depth and refinement.
