Battles Blendaberg 2024

Shows vibrancy with intense fruit characters of grapefruit, mandarin, finger lime and a delicate ginger spice note. Lingering, long and dry, with an upfront silky texture. There is a great balance between the salivating acid, powerful fruit intensity yet delicacy in its palate weight. Clean and pronounced aromas of kaffir lime, lemon-grass, ginger, orange blossom and a gentle lychee lift.

Battles Burnside Chardonnay 2024

This Chardonnay has a medium bodied palate that has elegance and texture, imparted through lees stirring during time spent in barrel. There is a nice interplay between the acid spine, cheese rind and stonefruit flavours before a lingering saline finish. Clean and pronounced aromas of nectarine and white flowers with hints of lime and some funky flint and nougat notes. There are complexing aromatic notes of cinnamon, cashew and cream from time spent in oak.

Battles Shiraz 2023

The palate is full bodied with a deep core of dark fruits and a persistent tannin structure, which helps the wine draw long, with some gentle spice and savoury notes on the finish. Clean and vibrant, lifted aromatics are one of the hallmarks of this Shiraz. Aromatics of purple flowers and violets are underpinned by blackberry and red cherry fruit. A truly unique West Australian Shiraz.

Battles Malbec 2024

This Malbec shows the classic lush mid palate of the variety with dark red and black fruits. The texture and flavour build seamlessly on the pallet. The finish lingers with perfumed notes and fine integrated tannins. Floral and perfume aromatics, blackcurrant pastille, red jubes with gentle spice and savoury notes.

Battles Wine was created by Lance Parkin and Kris Ambrozkiewicz in 2018. Lance has been a winemaker in Australia for 20 years, while also undertaking vintages throughout Europe in the Douro Valley, Mosel, Barolo and Burgundy. Kris owns and runs his own wine distribution business and works as a Sommelier at Rockpool Perth. The third member of the team is renowned Sommelier and Beverage Director of Neil Perry's Margaret Family Group in Sydney, Richard Healy.

Battles first vintage in 2019 was two tonnes of Chardonnay from Margaret River. They now source grapes and make wine from the Perth Hills, Geographe, Margaret River and the Great Southern.

Great reviews and awards have continued the success of this wine brand, including the Halliday 2023 Best Shiraz for the 2020 Battles Granitis Shiraz and the West Australian Good Food Guide 2023 Wine of the Year for the 2022 Battles Frankland Shiraz.
