Shiraz is the big player in the Clare Valley – the most planted grape variety, favoured for its richness and savoured for its vitality. Devilishly dark

Super complex – crushed blackberry, olive tapenade, shaved dark chocolate

Palate:

A serious, dark shiraz spectrum of flavours, black plums and berries, black olive tapenade – an estate character – with a lovely spike of fresh, crushed blackberry midway.

Totally integrated oak, sticky, lip-smacking structure and impressive length.
