About Koonara

We are a small family owned and organically certified winery in the heart of Coonawarra. In 1906 my great grandfather, named the family property 'Koonara'. More than 115 years on, our family still live here surrounded by our vineyards.

We are the first in Coonawarra to be Certified Organic, and we have created ecosystems in our vineyards to limit spraying (even organic sprays) and to reduce our carbon footprint.

We believe in creating wines which are high quality and age-worthy. All our wines are vegan friendly, low in sulphur and have no (or low) residual sugar.

We are very proud of our wines and hope you enjoy them.

About Koonara

- We're practising organic viticulture in our vineyards. We average four sprays per year for disease with only organically certified products so as not to harm our delicate ecosystem. No pesticides have been used in our Coonawarra vineyards for 10 years.
- No oak substitutes (no chips, planks, dominos, etc) are used to make our wines. It means our wines won't be the cheapest but aged in 100% oak barrels means the highest quality.
- French Oak barrels. All of our reds are aged in 100% fine-grain French Oak Hogsheads barrels. These are the most expensive barrels, costing upwards of \$1,800 a barrel, but the flavours are far superior.
- No residual sugar in any of our reds and below 3g/L of sugar in our whites. They still taste sweet, showing perfect balance in the vineyard. **The exception to this is in our Moscato, and just a touch in our sparkling white & red.
- Low yields, small grapes and big flavour. Both our Coonawarra vineyards yield 2 tonnes or less - the average for Coonawarra is 3.5 - 4 tonnes. However, this doesn't mean we have less grapes. Koonara grapes are smaller, which means more skin per litre. The colour and flavour comes from the skin, this results in more colour and flavour; the vine can perfectly ripen smaller, thick-skinned grapes (the size of a pea - see picture).
- Former Wynns winemaker for 15 years Peter Douglas is our winemaker, one of the most respected winemakers and wine judges in Australia.
- Famous Coonawarra terra rossa soil. All our Coonawarra vines are planted on the famous terra rossa soil, situated on our property which has been in the family for over 100 years.

In the 2015 vintage, it had only organic additives, and no pesticides (none have been used in this vineyard for over 10 years).

We aged this wine for 24 months in the finest French Oak barrels. Only 3 barrels were chosen as good enough – creating only 100 cases.

The Big Guns is a tribute to my father Trevor Reschke, who was in the Australian national team for clay target shooting, and the state team over 20 times. More often than not you would find him shooting crows in this vineyard just before vintage. To this day crows still avoid it.

We aged this wine for 24 months in the finest French Oak barrels. From these, only the most complex flavours from the finest barrels were selected. This year only 3 barrels made the cut, creating only 100 cases.

The Big Guns will age well until 2030. Here's to you Trev.
