Canyonleigh sits at 750 metres above sea level located in the Southern Highlands in New South Wales. With an average rainfall of 26 inches, Canyonleigh is a lot dryer than the main parts of the Southern Highlands, which averages 46 inches. Canyonleigh is an area known for rugged terrain enriched with rocky sandy loam soil and a clay base that is a perfect combination for producing cool climate produce including grapes and olives.

2018 Brut Méthode Traditionelle RRP \$60

Delicate nose with white nectarine and a little honey, and subtle overtones of brioche. With a fine, soft palate with good balance, this wine finishes dry, with a light texture.

N.V Sparkling

RRP \$25

Yellow golden colour. The nose shows fresh aromas of stone fruit with a hint of strawberries. Light bodied. The palate is zesty and crisp. This wine finishes clean and refreshing.



2018 Sparkling Rosé

RRP \$25

Bold blushing pink in colour. Fresh nose of strawberries and summer fruits. Light bodied. The palate is vibrant showing strawberry characters. This wine has a refreshing finish.





2021 Berrima Blush Single Vineyard RRP \$25

Rose gold in colour. Aromatic nose showing raspberries. Light bodied. The palate is soft with attractive red fruit flavours. This wine finishes sweet with a little cleansing acidity.





2018 Riesling

RRP \$25

Light, bright yellow colour. Intense nose with fragrances of a little citrus, stone fruit and distinct honey. The palate is similar to the nose. This wine finishes crisp and dry.



2019 Riesling Single Vineyard RRP \$28

Pale yellow colour. A lemon aroma with a little toast from development in bottle. Citrus and apple flavours mingle in the mouth. The finish is crisp and dry.

2019 Pinot Gris Single Vineyard RRP \$30

Pale bronze/yellow. Fine, fragrant aromas of pear and white nectarine. Medium body, white stonefruit flavours.



2019 Chardonnay Single Vineyard RRP \$35

Pale yellow-straw colour. White peach and a little oak on the nose. Medium body, with attractive white peach flavours and light nuttiness from oak. It finishes with nicely persistent flavours.

Reds



2019 Pinot Noir Single Vineyard RRP \$45

Light-mid red with garnet tinges. Fragrant red cherry and raspberry on nose, with a little redcurrant. Intense, medium-bodied palate with plenty of fresh red fruits. Finishes with fine tannins, and a little refreshing acidity.



2021 Gamay Noir Single Vineyard RRP \$30

Pale red purple with a fragrant red cherry, red currant nose. A supple wine with plum red fruits finishing with a brush of soft tannin and refreshing acidity.



2019 Merlot Single Vineyard RRP \$30

Intense nose of ripe red currant and plum. The palate is rich, complex and balanced with plum, dried herbal flavours and a hint of tobacco, concluding with soft subtle tannins.

2018 Tempranillo RRP \$32

Medium to deep purple red colour. Red and blue berries on the nose with subtle oak aromas. Medium bodied. Elegant palate with an abundance of berry flavours. Fine tannins. Drink now and over the next three years.

Reds



2017 Shiraz RC RRP \$25

Deep red colour. Red fruits and spices on the nose. Medium body. Attractive flavours, following through with spices and ripe fruits, with good balance and positive tannins. Moderate length.

2017 Shiraz CCSH RRP \$30

Deep red colour. The nose has red fruits, spices and black pepper. Full bodied. The palate has sweet red fruits. The wine finishes with balanced acidity.

2016 Shiraz CCRC RRP \$45

Deep red colour with garnet on the edge. The nose has sweet plums. Medium-full bodied. The palate is inviting with ripe plum flavours. The wine finishes with balanced acidity.

2019 Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot RRP \$35

Mid-deep red. Blackcurrant and red fruits on nose with a little leafiness and vanilla from oak. Medium body. Good, firm Cabernet structure and flavour. Dark and red berries. Balanced, dry tannins and nice length.

2018 Cabernet Sauvignon RRP \$35

Medium red colour with a little purple. Fragrant nose, with violets, red berries and leafy overtones. Medium body. Elegant berry flavours, finishing with a fine tannin grip.
