

GLOBAL MASTER-WINNING MARANANGA SHIRAZ

The Hare's Chase 2019 Marananga Shiraz has been judged as one of just eight Master-winning wines at this year's Drinks Business Global Syrah Masters, with this competition being the biggest of its type in the UK. Of the eight wines that received Master status six came from the Barossa Valley, reflecting the regional pedigree for this variety.

Masters judge Patrick Schmitt MW portrayed this wine as being "...a wonderfully indulgent, textbook Syrah from the Marananga GI. This is a bold and beautiful glass of Syrah that's also brilliantly Barossa."

"This fabulous recognition of our Marananga Shiraz is a great reward to all involved and a testament to the long-term vision, investment and support of our family-owned estate", said senior winemaker Matt Reynolds upon hearing about the award.

"Our wines from this truly remarkable site within Marananga, offer insight into the unique landscapes and complexity of wine styles produced at Hare's Chase."



This is the second international award that the 2019 Hare's Chase Marananga Shiraz has received, as it won a Gold Medal at the MundusVini Summer Tasting earlier this year.

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
