Paracombe Awarded Best Producer Over 100 Tonnes 2021 Adelaide Hills Wine Show

Paracombe Wines has been awarded Best Producer Over 100 tonnes at the 2021 Adelaide Hills Wine Show. The trophy was presented at the prestigious Adelaide Hills Wine Show Lunch, hosted at the National Wine Centre on December 2nd. This amazing accolade was as a result of Paracombe being the highest awarded producer, receiving an unprecedented tally of 20 medals at the wine show, proudly winning 6 Gold, 2 Silver and 12 Bronze medals in total.

The award winning wines are –

Gold – 2016 Shiraz, 2016 The Reuben, 2018 Tempranillo, 2021 Pecorino, 2017 Dimenticato Shiraz and 2013 Reserve Nebbiolo.

Silver – 2021 Pinot Gris and 2021 Riesling .

Bronze – Pinot Noir Chardonnay Sparkling , A Trio of Pinot, 2021 Sauvignon Blanc, 2021 Pinot Blanc, 2021 Red Ruby, 2021 Pinot Noir, 2015 Shiraz, 2015 Shiraz Viognier, 2013 Somerville Shiraz, 2013 MacGillivray Shiraz, 2016 Malbec and 2015 The Reuben.

The Adelaide Hills Wine Show demonstrates the region's remarkable diversity, and how the pioneering and boundary-pushing philosophy of its winemakers is coming to fruition. The first Adelaide Hills Wine Show took place in 1997 to recognise and reward the region's winemakers and grape-growers for the quality of their wines in over 20 categories. The judging team of 16 industry experts reviewed around 630 different wines.

Paracombe was established nearly 40 years ago in 1983 by Kathy and Paul Drogemuller when they bought an old dairy farm following the Ash Wednesday bushfires. Today they built up a successful family owned business have rightfully earned a reputation for producing a broad portfolio of wines from aromatic whites through to rich, well balanced reds.

Owner, founder Kathy Drogemuller said this accolade truly celebrates our wine, highlighting how significant our location is here at Paracombe on our ancient 1.7 billion year old plateau where the cool climate, high altitude, ancient soils, and gentle sunshine hours all come together to provide influence in our wines. The Adelaide Hills is recognised as one of the most exciting, premium wine regions in the world and we're proud to be a part of it.
