Our wine regions

Hunter Valley

Altitude: 130m | Soil: Sandy alluvial to deep friable loams

Australia's oldest wine region, here the warm humid climate of the Hunter is tempered by afternoon sea breezes. There's a wide variety of terroir, from the red volcanic soils producing some of Australia's most long-lived Shiraz wines to the sandy river beds that are home to the region's famous Semillon wines.

Tumbarumba

Altitude: 800m | Soil: Decomposed granite and basalt to red sand over clay

This remote, cool-climate region is one of the highest in Australia. The first vines were planted in 1981, on the western slopes of the Snowy Mountains made up of ancient soils derived from decomposed granite and basalt even red sand over clay in parts, at an elevation ranging from 500–950 metres. It's known for producing some of the country's finest examples of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and traditional method sparkling wines. Renowned for brilliant sunlight days with cold summer nights.

Hilltops

Altitude: 450m | Soil: Dark red granite clays with basalt

Located 150km west of Canberra, the Hilltops region enjoys a cool and dry continental climate. The first commercial vines were planted in the 1970s although its history for wine predates World War II and is known for producing rich, vibrant Mediterranean red varietals in addition to Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz.







Winemaker Bryan Currie

Bryan has built a formidable reputation as a talented, award-winning winemaker. He was nominated by Gourmet Traveller Wine Magazine for the 2012 'Winemaker of the Year' and in 2009 was selected by the wine industry as a 'Future Leader'. Bryan was also a scholar at the prestigious Len Evans Tutorial in 2007.

Working closely with his viticulture team on our Hunter Valley vineyards and managing the closest relationships with our growers, understanding their properties in both Tumbarumba and Hilltops. Bryan's expertise on NSW wine regions has positioned him well to guide Hungerford Hill and its single estates of Sweetwater & Dalwood Estate through their next chapter. Hungerford Hill has solely been producing wines from NSW as of 2017.



Hungerford Hill

At Hungerford Hill, we take great pride in our long-standing reputation for producing distinguished wines and providing unforgettable experiences. Guided by Bryan Currie, our highly accomplished and award-winning winemaker, the Hungerford Hill team consistently produces wines of character and interest that focus on the Hunter Valley and NSW's cool-climate regions of Hilltops and Tumbarumba.

Established in 1967 by the Parker Family, the history of Hungerford is long and complex, and it's most recent chapter began in December 2016 when Sam Arnaout purchased the winery. He had visions of a Hungerford Hill with a greater focus on Hunter Valley wines along side Tumbarumba & Hilltops, with that vision he also managed to acquire the renowned Sweetwater and Dalwood Estate vineyards. With an award-winning cellar door, hosting Muse restaurant, Hungerford Hill is now in the enviable position of being able to offer an all-encompassing wine and food experience worthy of its name.

The Sydney Harbour Bridge, opened in 1932, marked the start of a new era in Australia's history and is now revered as an icon and engineering masterpiece. Hungerford Hill's Heavy Metal is an echo of this period, when Australian winemaking philosophy was founded on cross regional blending to consistently craft a wine to house style.

Sweetwater Estate

Sweetwater wines are entirely grown on the Sweetwater property, located on the elevated Sweetwater Ridge in Belford, part of the northern end of the Lower Hunter Valley.

Historically the Sweetwater Station had vineyards planted from 1829 by Richard Jones an English pastoralist. The Vineyard was replanted in 1998. Unique for red loamy soil over limestone otherwise referred to as "Terra Rossa".

Sweetwater wines stands as a symbol of magnificence and produces distinctive wines of the highest quality with a fragrant floral fruit character and rich textural tannins.

Dalwood Estate

Established in 1828 by George Wyndham, this is the oldest serving vineyard in Australia.

Originally Dalwood Estate purchased cuttings from the first Australian vine collections of Macarthur, Busby, Shepherd and Blaxland.

Early colonial Dalwood wines from this vineyard won prizes at international exhibitions. It's a very proud heritage to continue.

The soils at Dalwood Estate migrate from sand and gravel on the Hunter River for Semillon and Chardonnay to red loam for Shiraz, Tempranillo and Touriga.
