Mount Hurtle Winery - The Home of Geoff Merrill Wines

Built in 1897, **Mount Hurtle Winery** was set on 200 acres of prime Reynella hillside. The winery itself was innovative for its time, using the principles of gravity to feed wine throughout the cellars. Because of this, the building is now state heritage listed.

Today, **Mount Hurtle Winery** is an oasis among suburbia, nestled in 4 acres of vineyards and landscaped gardens. It is hard to believe when Geoff purchased Mount Hurtle in 1985 it was a derelict building, run down and dilapidated. It required two years of love, hard work and special vision by Geoff and his supporters to restore the winery and vineyard to its former glory.

While retaining an almost Tuscan charm, the original winery and the 1500 square metre barrel maturation cellar, completed in 1998, now perfectly copes with the rigors of modern-day winemaking. A large family of geese and ducks also inhabit the winery grounds and dam near the front entrance to the estate.





Geoff Merrill - The Man

Born in 1953, **Geoff Merrill** was raised in the far North of South Australia and relocated to the Barossa Valley in his teens before undertaking a winemaking traineeship at B Seppelt & Son. He was lured to South Africa for a year as Experimental Winemaker at Stellenbosch Farmers Winery before travelling through Europe.

In 1975 Geoff returned to Australia to take on the role of Assistant Winemaker at Chateau Reynella and in 1977 was promoted to Senior Winemaker, a position he held until 1985 while finding the time to also make wines under his own "Geoff Merrill" label. These wines were first released in 1983 with a 1980 Cabernet and a 1981 Semillon.

In 1993, Geoff also took up a position as Consultant Winemaker to UK supermarket Sainsbury and Gruppo Italiano Vini in Italy. Since then Geoff has concentrated on the winery and his wines and has continued to gain national and international recognition for his distinctive style of winemaking and his zest for life.





Our Winemaking Philosophy

The Geoff Merrill winemaking philosophy has been and will always be to produce wine that allows regional, varietal and vintage expression, without excessive winemaker intervention. Great wine is a matter of balance, and our passion for subtle, elegant and harmonious flavours in wine is well documented.

We believe that maturation, both in barrel and particularly in bottle, at our cellars prior to release, plays an integral role in achieving this aim. The premium red wines from Geoff Merrill Wines will generally be released a minimum of 3 years from harvest, while our Reserve selection and Henley will be held in our cellars for over 7 years from harvest.

"When I first wrote winemakers notes for the early Geoff Merrill Wines labels, I often referred to the balance of my wine. Great wine is a combination of fruit, tannin, acid and sometimes oak, all being in balance. It was these references that inspired me to use a set of scales, depicting balance, as our corporate logo". – Geoff Merrill
