## 2019 Sparkling Chardonnay

### VARIETIES

100% Adelaide Hills Chardonnay

### WINEMAKING

Charmat Method

### CELLARING

10 years

### TASTING NOTES

Bright, light lemon colour with a long continuous chain of many fine bubbles. It has a peachy, pear and red apple nose with a little hint of yeast to add complexity. A clean, dry, delightful sparkling with intense fruit character and fresh dynamic acidity.

ALCOHOL 12.0% TA 7.1 g/L PH 3.09 RS 6.9 g/L



## 2020 'Nectar Thief' Sauvignon Blanc

### VARIETIES

100% single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc

### WINEMAKING

Low-yielding vineyard, strict low temperature fermentation

### CELLARING

Drink now

### TASTING NOTES

This wine smells like fresh-cut grass, mouth-watering pineapple sorbet and juicy green apples. It lands on the palate with a lime soda effervescence followed by guava and apple juice characters.

ALCOHOL 12.9% TA 7.9 g/L PH 3.14 RS 1.0 g/L



## 2018 'Three Pears' Chardonnay

### VARIETIES

100% single vineyard Chardonnay

### WINEMAKING

Hand picked grapes, seasoned French oak, barrel fermentation

### CELLARING

3-5 years

### TASTING NOTES


A lovely aroma followed by a powerful palate. Great energy and drive. This wine smells like apricot, lemon and dry straw. The palate is round, with flavours of yellow peach, lemon juice, vanilla and dry fruit, nicely balanced by the lively acid.

ALCOHOL 13.4% TA 6.9 g/L PH 3.34 RS 1.1 g/L

## 2020 Pinot Noir Rosé

**VARIETIES**  
100% Pinot Noir

**WINEMAKING**  
Strict low temperature fermentation, free-run juice

**CELLARING**  
Drink Now

**TASTING NOTES**  
Light and dry grapefruit citrus character followed by a flavourful raspberry and strawberry midpalate and a clean, refreshing finish.

**ALCOHOL** 11.0% **TA** 9.4 g/L **PH** 3.14 **RS** 0.8 g/L



## 2017 'Wheely Good' Pinot Noir

**VARIETIES**  
100% Lenswood Pinot Noir

**WINEMAKING**  
Open fermentation, extended maceration, natural yeast

**CELLARING**  
3-5 years

**TASTING NOTES**  
Bright red cherry and blood orange on the nose followed by a hint of dry herbal notes. The combination of floral and tart sour cherry is already mouthwatering and has a little touch of cinnamon and vanilla bean at the end of the palate.

## 2018 'Maggie's Song' Shiraz

**VARIETIES**  
100% Adelaide Hills Shiraz

**WINEMAKING**  
Open fermentation, light press, French oak

**CELLARING**  
5-7 years

**TASTING NOTES**  
This wine has a really beautiful fragrance. Elements of musk, pink peppercorn, raspberries and spice. Lovely palate weight with a black pepper thread and a shadow of oak.

**ALCOHOL** 14.8% **TA** 6.5 g/L **PH** 3.61 **RS** 0.6 g/L

Grapes are selected to deliver a more traditional style and taste with conventional structures.



## 2018 'O Series' Chardonnay

### VARIETIES

100% single vineyard Chardonnay

### WINEMAKING

Seasoned French oak, barrel fermentation, Bâttonaged

### CELLARING

5-7 years

### TASTING NOTES

Restrained savoury and gentle cashew-nutty aromas on the nose. the palate is similarly taut and reserved, with some creamy lees and nutty oak nuances, the acidity is fresh, zippy and lemony, with good persistence.

## 2018 'O Series' Pinot Noir

### VARIETIES

100% Lenswood Pinot Noir

### WINEMAKING

Bleeding, whole bunch fermentation, French barrel ageing

### CELLARING

3-5 years

### TASTING NOTES

Clear bright ruby colour. Sour cherry and raspberry nose lifted by wet leaves and mushroom. Fresh cranberry and red cherry palate with hints of licorice and lively yet smooth tannins.

ALCOHOL 13.5% TA 6.7 g/L PH 3.54 RS 0.7 g/L



## 2018 'O Series' Shiraz

### VARIETIES

100% Adelaide Hills Shiraz

### WINEMAKING

Open fermentation, 12-month barrel ageing, cold soaking

### CELLARING

5-7 years

### TASTING NOTES

A charming wine with its wafting red berry fragrance. Excellent fruit clarity and intensity. The palate is clean, bright and poised with excellent cranberry and redcurrant flavours plus a thread of sophisticated spice. Medium-bodied with good palate tension.

## 2017 'Reserve' Chardonnay

**VARIETIES**  
100% single vineyard Chardonnay

**WINEMAKING**  
Barrel fermentation, selected barrel

**CELLARING**  
5-7 years

**TASTING NOTES**  
Exaggerated style with grilled peach, burnt butter and smoky oak combining to form a rich, mouthfilling whole. It doesn't take a skerrick of a backward step but it keeps the pace high and it finishes as though it could pump out flavour all day (and night) long.

## 2018 'Reserve' Pinot Noir

**VARIETIES**  
100% single vineyard Pinot Noir

**WINEMAKING**  
Bleeding, whole bunch fermentation, selected barrel

**CELLARING**  
10-12 years

**TASTING NOTES**  
A delicious pinot, beautifully balanced and complex in flavour, savoury, deep and harmonious. Lots of dried-flowers, strawberry, raspberry aromas, with a dash of smoky oak. Long palate. A very finely textured, delicious wine of understated power.

## 2018 'Reserve' Shiraz

**VARIETIES**  
100% single vineyard Shiraz

**WINEMAKING**  
Open fermentation, natural yeast, selected barrel

**CELLARING**  
10-12 years

**TASTING NOTES**  
Deep red/purple hue, with a very spicy, cool-grown aromatic bouquet, white pepper included. The wine is elegantly-framed and medium to full-bodied, but powerful, with fine tannins and lovely approachability, line and length. There's underlying juiciness which is utterly delicious. Irresistible.

We use our skill and passion to capture the unique characters and flavours of our grapes in every bottle of wine.

Anderson Hill has won multiple local and international awards and medals and exports to Europe, Asia and North America.


The Anderson Hill portfolio includes:
