Wines from McLaren Vale



2018 Reserve Shiraz

Select fruit from the Lacey vineyard in the Tatachilla sub region of southern McLaren Vale. Sandy Loam over limestone base scattered with ironstone fragments, 1654 clone vines planted on their own roots. Selectiv[®] harvested and transferred directly to open fermenter with no destemming/crushing or pumping in order to maintain the whole berries. Cultured yeast used, 14-day open fermentation, hand plunged. Pressed to a single new French Puncheon where it was matured for 18 months.

No fining, no filtration, hand bottled. Only 55 dozen produced.

Bottle aged for a minimum of 2 years.

Dark fruited with fine lingering tannins. A powerful wine in the modern-traditional style.
