

Langhorne Creek

35.2963°S - 139.0383°E Altitude 30m Growing Season Rainfall 140mm

One of the best-kept secrets in Australian viticulture, Langhorne Creek is one of Australia's oldest wine regions. The region is nestled among gum trees on the Bremer and Angas rivers. Langhorne Creek is less than a one-hour drive from Adelaide.

Regional Winemaking

Alongside its famous Cabernet Sauvignon – the powerhouse behind many of Australia's most famous red blends since the 1960s – Langhorne Creek produces full bodied Shiraz and Malbec.

Langhorne Creek Wines tend to be medium to full bodied, aromatic and fruit driven with firm, integrated tannins and persistent length. Generally the wines are immediately accessible, soft and fragrant. Flavours are in the red berry spectrum, often with gentle minty and chocolate overtones.

In recent years these classics have been joined by some of Australia's most thrilling wines being made from alternative varieties. Varieties like Fiano, Vermentino, Lagrein and Tempranillo are capturing critics' attention for their superb varietal expression as captured through the lens of Langhorne Creek's extraordinary terroir.

CLIMATE

Langhorne Creek has a cool maritime climate with a mean January temperature of 19.9°c and 1520 heat degree days. This is due to the onshore southerly winds coming off Lake Alexandrina, a 600 sq km body of fresh water at the end of the Murray Darling River system, 3 times the size of Sydney Harbour.

The wind carries its cooling effect across the lake directly from the Antarctic and Southern ocean. There is no land to warm or moderate the wind before it reaches our vines. The influence it has on our climate is dramatic; The prevailing southerlies reduce daytime temperature fluctuations, it moderates summer heat and mitigates winter frosts. The majority of rainfall occurs in winter and spring.

Soil

Langhorne Creek's fertile soils are predominantly deep, alluvial sandy loams that vary in colour from red-brown to dark grey, with patches of black, self-mulching clays.

SAUVIGNON BLANC Betty & Lu

This wine is produced using fruit from several blocks of our own Langhorne Creek vineyards. A cool growing season provides the ultimate ripening conditions for developing and capturing the true varietal character of Sauvignon Blanc.

This fresh zesty example of Sauvignon Blanc has lifted aromas of fresh grass and citrus with a crisp refreshing palate that is complemented by lovely mouth-watering acidity.



VERDELHO Mollie & Merle

The grape variety Verdelho has been grown in Langhorne Creek for over 150 years. It is perfectly suited to our region's climate and growing conditions.

We have chosen to make a fresh, vibrant style of Verdelho to express the pure varietal characters. We have used only free run juice, providing a clean, focused Verdelho with lifted perfumed citrus aromas. The palate is bright and textural with fine acid balance and great length of flavour.



ROSÉ Racy

Produced from 100% estate grown fruit, the Racy Rosé is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz picked when the flavour profile and ripeness is perfect for the savoury dry style we are aiming for.

The grapes are pressed for minimal colour extraction and fermented dry before bottling to capture the freshness.

On the palate the wine is racy and moreish, with savoury fruit, textural palate and a fine dry finish.



CABERNET / SHIRAZ / MALBEC / MERLOT TAMBLYN

The Tamblyn blend expresses the characteristics of the different varietals providing a complex flavour profile with a soft tannin finish; Cabernet Sauvignon provides the framework, Shiraz adds berry fruit weight, Malbec adds a perfumed lift and intense colour and the Merlot rounds out the palate.

SIGNATURE RANGE



CABERNET SAUVIGNON COULTHARD

Cabernet has a very long history in Langhorne Creek and is one of the original red varietals that established the region.

It displays a classic ripe cassis aroma with supportive savoury notes. A well balanced palate showing ripe dark fruits enhanced by a silky textural finish.

Individual Cabernet parcels were fermented separately in small open fermenters to allow excellent extraction of colour and flavour. Each batch was matured in a combination of new and older French and American oak barriques for 18 months.



Shiraz Selkirk

Our Selkirk Shiraz offers distinctive varietal characters of lifted white pepper aroma, dark berry fruit, plum and savoury spice. It displays a well-balanced palate structure, soft supple tannins and well integrated oak.

After fermenting in small open top fermenters the wine spent up to 18 months in selected new and older fine grain American and French oak. Parcels were chosen to give the final blend the best balance between varietal fruit character, complexity and structure.

Special Release Range



Vermentino

Vermentino is widely planted in the Italian regions of Liguria (primarily under the name Pigato), the Mediterranean Islands of Sardinia and Corsica, and in Piedmont (under the name Favorita).

Our Vermentino has personality and texture. A refreshingly aromatic and bright wine full of lemon, citrus pith and elements of sea spray character backed up with mouth watering acidity and a lingering finish.



FIANO

Fiano is a white Italian wine grape variety that is grown primarily in Southern Italy and on the island of Sicily. The Bremerton Fiano is aromatic and intensely flavoured giving fresh lifted citrus curd notes balanced by a textural nuttiness and fresh acidity.

In typical Italian style we believe this wine will provide the most enjoyment drunk with food to express its true varietal uniqueness. The wine will continue to develop mouthfeel and texture with additional bottle maturation.



Tempranillo / Graciano

Tempranillo is the backbone grape variety in Northern and Central Spain. Graciano is a grape variety that is used mostly in blends with Tempranillo providing lifted florals, spice and acid balance.

The wine is a great example of how these two Spanish varieties complement each other. Berry, dark rose and spice notes frame the palate in a medium weight, juicy wine. It is well balanced and supported by fine tannins and structural acid.



MALBEC

Malbec, a variety once popular in Bordeaux France, is now mostly associated with countries such as Argentina, and regions such as Cahors in South West France. Langhorne Creek has a long history with Malbec and the climate is exceptionally well suited.

Bremerton Malbec is the result of block selection, the parcels have been kept separate and nurtured for maximum expression of varietal character. This wine shows an intense perfumed aroma of violets and spice with a bramble lift, on the palate the wine is rich and fleshy with fine tannins.

Bâtonnage Range



CHARDONNAY

This chardonnay is a single vineyard selection of premium fruit sourced from our vineyards at Bremerton.

The Chardonnay juice was individually barrel fermented with a range of solids. It was barrel fermented with majority indigenous wild yeast and matured in 20% new and older French oak barriques for 11 months and during this time we stirred the lees (Bâtonnage) to provide added complexity.

On the nose this wine shows lifted lemon curd with hints of stone fruit and spice. The palate is expressive and complemented by restrained oak and a creamy mouthfeel. The palate is tempered by a fine acid structure and textural finish giving the wine great length and persistence.



SHIRAZ / MALBEC

Winemaking experimentation and a passion for Malbec have led to the development and release of this wine. Our Shiraz Malbec is a selection of premium fruit sourced from our vineyards at Bremerton.

The nose shows lifted violet and spice, complemented by a palate showing purity of varietal fruit. This red fruit and white spice is balanced by the structural complexity of fine French oak and a textural finish.

The Shiraz and Malbec parcels were barrel fermented then matured in French oak barriques for 16 months. During this time we stirred the yeast lees (Bâtonnage) of the Malbec to provide mid palate complexity and mouth feel prior to blending.

Premium Range



Shiraz Old Adam

The Old Adam is a combination of parcels of wine from the best blocks of shiraz from our vineyards.

The Old Adam is an excellent example of premium Langhorne Creek shiraz, showing intensity of rich fruit flavours and elegant intergrated oak, providing a delicious well structured complex wine. Every vintage, each parcel of shiraz is assessed and the most outstanding are nurtured to complete 22 months maturation before being blended to create the Old Adam. This maintains the quality, distinction and reputation of this fine wine.

The concentrated, high quality parcels of fruit were fermented in open vats and then matured for 22 months in new and seasoned specifically selected, extra fine grain American and French Oak. Additional 12 months maturation in bottle allows full integration of oak and fruit tannin.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON WALTER'S RESERVE

The Walter's Reserve Cabernet is a powerful yet elegant wine, showing gorgeous varietal notes of blackberry, bramble and earth, complemented by subtle influences of chocolate and savoury nuances.

The wine is supported by a fine, defining, elegant tannin structure and shows spice and complexity from the careful use of new French oak. This wine is very secretive as it takes its time to reveal itself, a powerful wine that will not only evolve in the glass but will reward you with patience in the cellar.

Individual Cabernet Sauvignon parcels were fermented in open vats then matured in new and seasoned French oak barrels for 22 months. Two years additional bottle maturation allows further flavour development and tannin integration before the wine's release.
