Originally wine exporters, in 2014 the Liu brothers took a century-old, run-down vineyard and built it from scratch into a winery and cellar door. Through years of hard work, we've created organic, sustainably produced wines with their own rich and unique flavour.

In their early winemaking journey, two brothers, Philip and Kevin developed a passion for winemaking. They studied at the University of South Australia and the University of Adelaide where they completed Master degrees in Marketing and Oenology.

While studying the brothers discovered an old run-down vineyard on banks of the North Para River in Nuriootpa. They bought the land from the Scholz family to start their journey and their new business – Ubertas Wines.

Like his brother Kevin, Philip immigrated to Australia in 2007. He has a Masters in Oenology (winemaking) from the University of Adelaide and he is passionate about organic farming that enriches the soil and creates full-flavoured grapes.

Kevin grew up in Taiwan before immigrating to Australia in 2007. He had his start in agriculture working on his grandfather's rice fields, which was labour-intensive and instilled a sense of hard work and respect for the land.

Our Region

A blend of internationally renowned labels and artisan winemakers makes the Barossa one of the best-known wine regions in the world. The cool climate and sandy soils provide optimal wine growing conditions, and there are over 80 cellar doors and 150 wineries waiting to be discovered.

Our Venue

Join us for a tasting at Ubertas Wines in our new modern cellar door, with large picture windows overlooking our vineyards. In the summer, bring your picnic rug and local produce filled picnic and sit out on the lawns to enjoy. The kids can run around and play while you sit back and relax. In the winter you can snuggle up on one of our leather couches in front of our big stone fireplace and warm your heart with a glass of Ubertas wine.

Our beautiful venue is available for hire for private events and we run music and food events throughout the year.





The Barossa Maze

Ubertas Wines is building the Barossa Maze, a 2,300 sqm play area made entirely of native Australian plants. Kids can spend an hour exploring the Maze while you supervise from the balcony, wine in hand.

The Maze project commenced in early 2020, and will be open to the public in 2024.

In our mission to showcase the best and the unique of Australia, the maze is grown from the native Red Alter plant (*Callistemon Viminalis*), which in turn attracts our native animals. Keep an eye out for Australian wild ducks during your visit.



Our Philosophy

Our goal is to produce wines with a 'sense of place'. Elegant wines with rich flavours, complexity and longevity. We're passionate about using sustainable practices both in the vineyard and the winery with minimal intervention to allow our wines to be the best expression of our Estate Vineyards.

Our Portfolio

Philip and Kevin Liu bought the vintage vineyard situated on the corner of Kalimna and research road in 2014. The first plantation at this vineyard was in 1912 growing Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Mataro.

The two brothers have started organic practice since 2017 and are strong believers in organic farming but the vineyard is not yet certified as an organic vineyard.





Native Guardian **Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz**

This Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz Blend is crafted by our winemaker Philip Liu from two premium vineyards in South Australia.

The Wine was made in a Fruity, Light - Medium body and easy drinking style. It shows aromas of Blackberry, Blueberry and red plum. Smooth texture on the palate with hint of French oaks finishing.



Single Vineyard **Chardonnay**

This Chardonnay was cold soaked for 36 hours before crushing. The juice was fermented with two different strains of yeast emphasising not only primary fruits, but also increased roundness in the palate.

50% of the wine was matured on fine lees in used French oaks for 6 months. This wine shows lifted primary fruits such as white peach, pineapple with refreshing acidity and a hint of French oak at finish.

Small Batch Merlot

2020 was a difficult vintage for the Barossa Valley with the average yield across the region at down by 40%. This was caused by below-average rainfall in winter, a temperamental spring and a hot, dry Summer!

However, this didn't stop us from producing this wonderful Small Batch Merlot. The grapes were picked at optimal ripeness when full of generous red fruit aromas characteristics like strawberry jam and red plum. There's even a hint of rich spices.

The Merlot was fermented in Traditional open-top fermentor and aged in French oak for 12 months. Merlot Shows smooth and silky texture on the palate with french oak finishing.

Single Vineyard Shiraz

2018 was a warmer vintage comparing to 2017.

The '18 Shiraz shows more generous fruits flavours such as dark plum and blackberry. The Shiraz is from our estate owned vineyard. Fruit was picked when it reached the right balance between flavour and acidity.



Single Vineyard Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon

2018 offers more generous fruit flavour on the nose due to warmer vintage comparing to 2017.

This wine was made with extra care to preserve the ripe fruit characteristics such as blackcurrant, blackberry and spice from our old vineyards which were planted in 1940's and 1980's respectively.

This Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon is crafted to mature over the next 8 to 10 years creating a wine of exceptional elegance and finesse.

Project D Shiraz

Our Single Vineyard estate grown Shiraz is crafted from 50 year old vines from the famous Barossa Valley. A small parcel of winemaker selected fruit is hand picked when showing flavours of blackberry, pepper and spice from our historic vineyard.

Made with traditional open top fermentation and matured in a combination of new and second use French oak for 16 months, Project D is crafted to mature over the next 10 to 15 years creating a wine of exceptional elegance and finesse.
