



SKILLOGALEE

TREVARRICK RIESLING

“Trevarrick Farm” was the original name of our property when it was first settled by John and Anne Trestrail in the 1850s. More than a century later in 1970, vines were planted on this magnificent land and the Skilloalee vineyards were established. When we harvest the grapes, each individual contour block on the estate picked and handled individually, the Trevarrick name is reserved for those contours which exhibit exceptional quality and varietal character of the vintage.

The grapes for the Trevarrick Riesling are selectively harvested from some of the highest altitude, slowest ripening contours on the property, at around 500m above sea level. The stony, thin soils and topography of this part of the vineyard produce unique, high-quality grapes bursting with varietal character.

VINTAGE

The 2022 vintage was one of outstanding quality, with delicate concentration of flavour and structure – producing truly great wines. Ample winter and spring rainfall ensured good soil moisture for our dry-grown vines, while the cool, dry weather through summer and early autumn provided ideal ripening conditions to produce fruit with high natural acidity and beautiful varietal flavour. The slow start and belated budburst, in combination with the cooler summer, resulted in one of the latest starts to harvest in more than a decade.

APPEARANCE

The wine is bright straw in appearance, with a green tinge.

NOSE

The nose has lifted aromatics of lime zest and jasmine flower.

PALATE

Crisp and lively, this generous wine offers elegant acidity invigorated by a clean zing of citrus and balanced mineral notes, tightly focussed structure and rocky succulent core. The bright flavours, natural acidity and a graceful structure display the unique terroir of our ancient soil and spectacular topography.

WHEN TO DRINK

With careful cellaring this wine should mature gracefully for ten+ years.

FOOD PAIRING

Pairs perfectly with fresh seafood and shellfish, along with contemporary Asian-style cuisine.
