Tasting Notes:

Beautifully structured and refined, the 2017 Thoroughbred shows intense aromas of wild cherry with hints of cloves, tomato leaf and dark chocolate. Elegant and generous berries jump out on the palate complimented with flavours of thyme, spice, roasted hazelnut, persisting through with structurally polished, velvety tannins providing a satisfying finish.

Winemaker Notes:

Small in size, the Cabernet Sauvignon berry can produce wine of great complexity. Prolonged fermentation on skins and patient maturation for 24 months in French and American oak casks has produced this wine with solid fruit flavors, vanillin oak characters and a bold finish.

Food Pairing: Kangaroo medallions with plum sauce, roast meats, rich slow-cooked beef brisket, BBQ Ribs, peppercrusted Ahi Tuna
