

Welcome

Hello and welcome to our Australian Wine Tasting. We're delighted to return to The Balmoral to host the biggest, brightest and most diverse showcase of Australian wine in Scotland.

With ancient soils, innovative winemakers and diverse climates, Australia has so much to offer. Australia is the size of Europe, but only around 145,000 hectares (0.02 per cent) of the country's total land mass is under vine, approximately the same area as Bordeaux and Burgundy combined. Australia is home to more than 150 grape varieties across 65 wine regions, where our creative winemakers are pushing the boundaries and crafting some of the most exciting wines in the world.

At this year's tasting we are showcasing more than 350 wines from 100 producers, ranging from the international superstars to the small boutique newbies. Explore wines from 37 regions across Australia and try 40 different grape varieties. Taste crisp vibrant whites, standout sparklings, elegant reds and thrilling alternative varieties. From the rogue to the refined, you'll discover Australian wines that are far from ordinary.

Some of the wineries today you may be familiar with, but others you might not have come across before. We extend a particularly warm welcome to the 10 producers that are seeking distribution in the UK – their tables are on the left-hand side as you enter the room.

Australia continues to be the number one country of origin in the UK off-trade market, with nearly twice the market share of its nearest rival Italy.

For Australian wine exports, the UK is the biggest market by volume – accounting for 36 per cent share of total export volume. Shiraz and Chardonnay, Australia's signature styles, are the top varieties exported to the UK as well as globally. Pinot Noir is also in the spotlight – exports of Australian Pinot Noir to the UK are up 28 per cent year on year.





Genista Wines is a husband-and-wife team made up of Lloyd Broom and Sarah Gregory. Purchasing our single vineyard in the southern Barossa Valley back in 2014, we now manage a total of 7 acres including 30-year-old Shiraz and 80-year-old Grenache vines. The name 'Genista' comes from the plant of the same name, with its common name being 'Broom'. A long running family joke – instead of being 'The Brooms', we would sometimes refer to ourselves as 'The Genistas' when feeling fancy. Since our first vintage in 2017, our philosophy has remained constant – produce the best quality fruit that we can, handle the resulting ferments and young wines as little as possible while ensuring high quality, and bottle wines showing varietal characteristics, texture and balance.

Remy Martin went to great lengths to identify the site they thought most suit for their requirements, deciding on a property in Avoca, Victoria. In addition to the Brandy business, they also wished to develop a méthode traditionnelle sparkling wine and full-bodied red wine business. Interestingly, that is still largely what we do. We are one of the largest méthode traditionnelle sparkling wine makers in Australia as well as being renowned for our full-bodied reds.
