2016 'COLD SWEAT' CRANEFORD SYRAH

2019 'FAT OF THE LAND' EBENEZER SHIRAZ

Single-vineyard shiraz from Ebenezer in the north of the Barossa Valley. Deep crimson in the glass with compressed blackberry and black cherry fruits. Pure and powerful in cedary oak and hints of Christmas cake spice, licorice, dark chocolate, tobacco leaf and turned earth. Big, bold and brooding with impressive horsepower and fruit heft.

2020 '2%' BAROSSA SHIRAZ



A splash (hence the 'two percent') of muscadelle backs its way into this red, which is predominantly built from Ebenezer, Seppeltsfield and Greenock shiraz. It's not a unique concept but it lends an exotic, floral edge to the proceedings. There is a deep, spicy resonance that acts as a base for the rich, ripe plum and blackberry fruits. Licorice-like and earthy, rich and opulent, there is plenty of concentration in display with compact sandy tannins and a spicy cassis tide of the finish.

2021 'MOTHER'S MILK' BAROSSA SHIRAZ



2021 was a fine vintage in the Barossa. There is no doubt that this wine will improve but damn it's delicious now. Deep plum and cherry fruits, plenty of spicy depth with hints of licorice, dark chocolate and earth. It's plush yet has crunch and cadence as it races off with memories of maraschino cherries, spice and roasting meats.

2021 'THE MATADOR' BAROSSA GRENACHE



There is a lighter, almost pinot-esque aspect to the colour in the glass. Aromas of satsuma plum, mulberry and boysenberry fruits are underscored with hints of gingerbread, cola, souk-like spice and floral notes galore. Red fruited and juicy on the palate with a medium-weighted line, fine casual tannins and an airy, spicy trail of plummy fruit.

2019 'MOTHER'S RUIN' MCLAREN VALE CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Cabernet sauvignon from the Willunga foothills. Shows a deep crimson hue and lifted aromas of bright blackcurrant and blackberry fruits along with hints of baking spices, licorice, blackcurrant jubes, dried herbs, sarsaparilla, cloves, mint and pipe tobacco. Pure black fruit on the palate segues to a savoury palate shape with a nice cadence, tight, fine tannins and a herbflecked blackcurrant pastille exit.



2022 'NACIONAL' MCLAREN VALE TOURIGA NACIONAL

Sleek, glossy and featuring a breezy sense of drinkability, it is little wonder that Portuguese grape varieties are winning us over. Deeply coloured with a plush dark plum and blueberry fruit base, plenty of earthy, spicy notes and a floral flick of the tail, the tannins are relatively gentle and powdery, retreating back into the fruit and the cadence is bright. Zesty yet fruit-driven and good drinking.

2022 'MODERNO' ADELAIDE HILLS BARBERA



From the shock of purple swirling around in the glass, you just know this is going to be a slurpy little number. It's all blueberry and cranberry fruit with citrus blossom top notes, Medina spices, dried citrus rind and dried herbal undertones. Supple and textured with a gypsum-dust tannin cloud, a twang of morello cherry at the backend and some nice sapid acidity getting the saliva glands working overtime. It makes for delicious, sprightly drinking.

2022 'REAL TIME' ADELAIDE HILLS CHARDONNAY



Chardonnay sourced from 350m elevation at Gumeracha in the Adelaide Hills; whole-bunch pressed and fermented in French oak puncheons (20% new). Pale straw with characters of crunchy green apple, nectarine and juicy peach with hints of cream wafer biscuits, lemon curd, soft spice, mango pudding, vanilla and creamy oak. Plenty of tight Hills focus on display with a driving mineral line and a finish that shows good sustain and spicy apple and peach fruit at its core.

2018 'FAT OF THE LAND' EBENEZER SHIRAZ

This is from hearty Barossa soil, offering rich blackberries, blueberries and licorice, as well as sarsaparilla and a coal smoke. The palate is saturated with ripe dark plums and blackberries and smooth tannins stack up nicely, delivering such intensity of flesh and flavor into the long, fresh finish.



2018 'FAT OF THE LAND' SEPPELTSFIELD SHIRAZ

This has attractive blueberry and cassis aromas with some violets and cedar, as well as dark stones and licorice. The palate has an essence-like depth of blueberry flavor with super ripe and plush, soft tannins holding the finish long

2020 'COLD SWEAT' MOCULTA SYRAH The finest wine of this 'Cold Sweat' suite. Full-bodied,

The finest wine of this 'Cold Sweat' suite. Full-bodied, to be sure. The oak, still unresolved but nicely nestled. The aromas, floral, lifted and palpably alive. Lilacs, tea-smoked duck, hoisin, cloves and blueberries. Complex. The finish is drawn taut by a string of acidity, while shuffling across a stacked tannic deck.



2020 '2%' BAROSSA SHIRAZ

Lots of blackberries, grilled meat, and hints of mint. Complete. Full-bodied with creamy tannins and a long and flavorful finish. Drinkable but even better in two or three years.



2021 'MODERNO' ADELAIDE HILLS BARBERA

A barbera with plenty of dark fruits, orange peel and other citrus fruit. Medium body. Fruity and juicy but the underlying acidity keeps it varietal and fresh. Says drink me!



2021 'MOTHER'S MILK' BAROSSA SHIRAZ

Aromas of black fruit, pepper, dark licorice and overturned earth. Medium- to full-bodied with creamy texture and fine tannins. It has a savory fruit character with some salinity to it.



2019 'MOTHER'S RUIN' MCLAREN VALE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Here's a ripe, savory and minty McLaren Vale cabernet. Surprising freshness and vitality in spite of the bold and full personality of the wine. Excellent integration of healthy tannins, bright acidity and a touch of minerality at the long finish.



2018 'MINCHIA' ADELAIDE HILLS MONTEPULCIANO

Dark berries with intense cloves and other spices, with a coffee liqueur and dark chocolate undertone. It's full-bodied and chewy with a pretty full-throttled nature, but I really like it.



2022 'VIVO' ADELAIDE HILLS ARNEIS

Tastes like arneis with candied lemons and limes with some steel and stone undertones.
Medium body. Really takes off at the finish. So much energy.

TConcentrated, with velvety black cherry and raspberry flavors that are juicy and vibrant at the core, joined by sandalwood, nutmeg and milk chocolate aromas and a touch of cedar. Packs generous lingering spices, including star anise and clove.

2018 'FAT OF THE LAND' SEPPELTSFIELD SHIRAZ

TOffers a core of wild berry preserves, cigar box spiciness, cedar aromas and fruit flavors of açaí, currant and blackberry. Boasts bittersweet chocolate and an edge of fresh-clipped laurel bay leaf, sage and rosemary herbs, which make for a complex, aromatic mix on a plush well-structured frame.



2018 'FAT OF THE LAND' GREENOCK SHIRAZ

Delivers dark, dense smoke, mahogany and black walnut notes, with accents of plum, salted black licorice and a thread of minerality. Shows appealing hints of cream soda and toast on a firm, plump frame

2018 'FAT OF THE LAND' EBENEZER SHIRAZ

Dense and concentrated, this red showcases clove, chai tea and bittersweet chocolate aromatics that mingle with a note of hot cast iron minerality, which adds an appealing high tone. Delivers dense, thick tannins and toasted herb flavors, which leave an appealing impression on the finish.

2021 'MOTHER'S MILK' BAROSSA SHIRAZ

A compelling red on a juicy, fresh frame, with smooth, polished tannins and fresh pomegranate and maraschino cherry flavors at the core, showing details of milk chocolate, nutmeg and white peppercorn, plus an appealing hint of toasted herbs and fresh earth. Reveals tannins that firm up on the finish, which packs a spicy kick.



2019 'MOTHER'S RUIN' MCLAREN VALE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Presents a lively, complex mix of red licorice, kirsch, oolong tea, oregano and dried cherry aromatics and flavors, with hints of lavender, palo santo and Kalamata olive that are wonderfully plush, juicy and generous. Shows soft, plush tannins.
