

The properties collaboratively produce over 6000 tonnes of popular premium style wine grapes over 238 hectares of vineyard. In addition to the vineyards, the properties also produce almond and citrus crops and are committed to conserving and enhancing significant areas of river floodplain and highland mallee vegetation





ECOVINEYARDS

A partnership between Retallick Viticulture, Winegrape Council of South Australia, and Riverland Wine. Reinvigorating an old River Red Gum and Black Box tree along a flood runner creek with locally occurring under storey and ground cover species near vines. Aims to blur the boundary between vineyard and natural ecosystem by adding flowering ground cover species under vine to build a native insectary of good bugs, suppress weeds, improve organic carbon levels and reduce sun burn and heat stress in extreme weather events.

ALTERNATIVE ENERGY

Electricity is second largest input behind irrigation water. In the face of a changing climate vital to reduce our energy footprint and increase our energy security with alternative energy options. Harnessing the natural asset of sunshine hours makes sense in the Riverland. A 100 kvA solar farm at the Litchfield property is covering 70% of our energy inputs and costs for pumping irrigation water from the Murray River.
