VINTAGE

The best winter rains in years meant that when the vines emerged from dormancy into bud burst, the soil was full of moisture. An official La Niña weather event brought a cooler, wetter-than-average spring, promoting healthy canopy growth. Despite some minor frost damage at our Watervale vineyard in October, most of the flowering took place in late November and early December during an unusually dry and calm period, resulting in good fruit set and an above-average crop. December was very dry, with less than 1mm of rain recorded. However, January and February saw above-average rainfall, which supported the vines through veraison, leading to the largest crop loads since 2017. March and April remained dry, providing ideal conditions for the bulk of our harvest.
