



A top 5 star rated winery by James Halliday, their wines have consistently won numerous awards over the last 40 plus years, both domestically and internationally, beginning all the way back in 1986 when their Capel Vale Riesling was named Australian National Dry White Champion. The beautiful cellar door has stunning views over the Capel vineyard and magnificent gardens.

THE REGION BOASTS THE MOST ANCIENT, ISOLATED WINE REGION IN THE WORLD

Great Southern Western Australia



Set on the side of a hill overlooking the southern coast of Australia, Castelli Estate is arguably one of Western Australia's most beautiful wineries. The Tudorstyle architecture of the winery, complete with stone walls and atmospheric underground barrel hall, is a contrast to the state-of-the-art winemaking facilities within.

The winery is partially operated with renewable energy. A dedicated solar generation system reduces our reliance on traditional energy sources, particularly during the busy vintage period.

The 8-ha vineyard is located high on our estate, outside of the small town of Denmark, Western Australia. The vineyard overlooks the Wilson Inlet – a large estuary that curls back on itself, forming a final barrier to the ocean.

Our fruit ripens slowly and surely, building complexity. The northerly aspect ensures optimal exposure to sunlight, building depth of flavour. In contrast to so much of Western Australia's sandy earth, the soil here is deep, red and rich. Fed from the towering Karri trees, our vines thrive with very little intervention.

In Wilyabrup, their historic Ironstone Vineyard yields exceptional single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay, while the original Clairault Vineyards in the North, boasting vines dating back to 1976, contribute various varietals and soil characteristics to their range. Additionally, the Clairault Vineyard

hosts a signature cellar door and vineyard kitchen.

At their Bridgeland Vineyard in Karridale, the cooler climate and extended growing season produce top-quality aromatic whites, including the award-winning Streicker Syrah.

At Clairault Streicker we believe that winemaking begins in the vineyard. With abundant water catchments, beautiful undulating landscapes, naturally biodiverse bushland, and soil that is exceptionally suited to premium viticultural use, our four vineyards are well-situated to produce fruit of uncommon quality.

As caretakers of four diverse vineyards in the Margaret River region, we are proud to be taking steps towards ensuring our natural resources are protected for generations to come. Our four vineyards are fully certified with Sustainable Winegrowing Australia. Since 1976, Clairault has been a pioneer in winemaking in Margaret River. Their wines, overseen by the esteemed local winemaker Bruce Dukes, embody an authentic and classic style that sets the standard for the Margaret River region.

Harvey River Estate is owned and operated by the Sorgiovanni family. The family have a long and significant history within the southwest agricultural industry. In 1928 Kevin's father emigrated from Italy and began farming on the banks of the Harvey River.

The Sorgiovanni orchards evolved into a standalone business and Harvey Fresh went on to become one of Western Australia's biggest milk and juice processors. While working in the family business Kevin continued to run cattle and operate vineyards in the area.

The winery business progressed from vineyards into wine production under the Harvey River

Estate label in 1999. The first commercial vintage was produced in 2000 and the winery went on to be awarded the Jimmy Watson award for its 2009 Joseph River Estate Cabernet Sauvignon.

With almost 50 acres under vine, planted to Chardonnay, Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon, these vineyards are some of the largest in the local area. Being to the northern zone of Geographe, the Harvey vineyards are the first to be harvested in the region, starting with the Chardonnay, followed by Shiraz and then Cabernet Sauvignon.

Winemaker, Stuart Pierce, strives to "make wines people want

to drink!" Stuart is very hands on in the vineyard and winery, ensuring wines are varietally expressive and typical of the region. His preference is for minimal intervention – to achieve this Stuart works very closely with the viticultural team to monitor fruit quality and maintain optimum vineyard conditions. During his long tenure with the business, many of Stuart's wines have received high accolades, including the prestigious Jimmy Watson Memorial Trophy in 2010.

Wilyabrup Western Australia



The Sorgiovanni family have a long history in agriculture from as early as 1928, and in 1999 the family wine business was established. The first vintage included fruit from multiply regions and the world-renowned Margaret River Region. After an extensive search, Kevin & his wife Joyce saw great potential in the Wilyabrup property, with its gently sloping topography bounded by the Wilyabrup Brook and right in the centre of Margaret River's 'golden triangle'.

The 165-acre property, which was originally a dairy farm, required extensive work including new fences throughout and creation of a large spring-fed dam. The small original vineyard was renovated,

and new plantings were also undertaken to bring the total acres under vines to 22.5. This includes some traditional varieties such as Cabernet and Chardonnay, and some lesser known alternatives such as Tempranillo, Malbec, Vermentino and Pinot Noir.

Planning for the creation of a cellar door and restaurant began immediately and the Fishbone venue opened in December 2015. Being a father to four daughters, Kevin wanted to create a welcoming destination, with a fresh menu that suited shared dining.

"I wanted to create a place where people can enjoy our Fishbone wines in a relaxed environment, and I wanted to offer something that Margaret River hadn't seen before."

The Fishbone Wines restaurant is now known for its Japanese inspired menu paired with the award winning wines produced under the Fishbone Black and Blue labels. The restaurant can seat up to 150 people and overlooks the vineyard & farm's paddocks, complete with Kevin's beloved cattle, all with a north-easterly aspect which keeps the terrace sunny in winter and protected in summer.

DEDICATED SPARKLING WINE PRODUCER. MÉTHODE TRADITIONNELLE Margaret River Western Australia



The original sparkling wine producer in Margaret River, John Frazer of Frazer Woods has been devoted to making wines from the region using méthode traditionnelle since the early 1990's. He has become one of Margaret River's most iconic sparkling wine producers, and the Frazer Woods name is synonymous with crafting wines of exceptional quality.

John was enjoying a quiet tipple at the local watering-hole on a Friday evening in the early 1980's, when he heard of a property for sale in Willyabrup. 40km southwest of his beer mat and lying between the forest and the massive expanse of Indian Ocean, this piece of land piqued an interest in John that was only increased by further enquiry.

Never ones to miss an opportunity,

John and his wife Jan Woods purchased the property at an auction at the Vasse Hotel on 14 December 1985. What would become Frazer Woods was mostly bushland, plus one large paddock and a shack with no electricity. But John and Jan recognised in it something they could grow, nurture and encourage into life. It had potential.

The ambition has always been to produce wines with a fine balance of fruit and complexity, whilst championing the Margaret River region. Crafted from local Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Shiraz, John makes his premium La Cache & Frazer Woods wines using méthode traditionnelle. Deep inside the quiet walls of the winery, the wine goes through secondary fermentation in bottle and embarks

on a long period of ageing sur lie an all-important process that is a hallmark of John's winemaking.

They have worked exceptionally hard since those early days, building the winery and their reputation, while also raising their family. More than a quarter of a century later, with the next generation of his sons Tom and Nick now working alongside their parents, this is a truly familyowned and run operation. John and Jan continue to innovate and invest in state of the art equipment for the winery, however with his background as an electrician, John is also never afraid of improvisation! Their passion and hope is that the business will continue on for many years to come, with plans for an ecofriendly cellar door already in the pipeline.

Jilyara is a rather magical blend of factors. A pristine pocket of Wilyabrup, destined for fine wine making. A meticulous hands-on vineyard manager. A free range fun loving family. And an abundance of buzzing bees.

In 1995 the family sentiment was let's give this a go. The vineyard was planted, and the seeds of a future in wine were sewn.

From their deep roots in grape growing, in 2018 the Cotterell-Bergstrom family birthed their wine label Jilyara - a dedication to pure, detailed, and expressive wines from the Margaret River Wine Region in Western Australia.

The vineyard's name Jilyara is derived from djilyaro, meaning

bees in the local indigenous Noongar language.

The equilibrium of the bush and the vineyard is a poetic narrative which underpins the natural beauty of the vineyard. Jilyara observes the six Noongar seasons to drive pruning, wire lifting, grazing and picking; Birak, Bunuru, Djeran, Makuru, Djilba and Kambarang.

The immaculate symmetry of the vineyard is an ode to its well-considered planting and Craig Cotterell, the perfectionist. The hand squished snails, individually plucked leaves, regenerative farming approaches, and eager eye for detail don't go unnoticed.

Winemaker Kate Morgan joined Jilyara in 2018 and has a natural affinity to Wilyabrup after spending nearly 10 years working with Fraser Gallop Estate. Drawing on her extensive local and international experience, Kate crafts wines of the highest quality; respecting the fruit and allowing the wine to express the terroir of the vineyard.

Celebrated as a finalist for both Young Gun Winemaker of the Year and Gourmet Traveller Young Winemaker of the Year, Kate's career which spans Australia, the United Kingdom, USA, and Portugal can be described as diverse, brilliant, and eminent.

Jilyara produces three distinct wine collections: Heath Road, Williams' Block and Honeycomb Corner.

Together, we are going to continue to make exceptional celebratory wines for families to enjoy for years to come." Kevin Sorgiovanni, Owner In 2014 we discovered a 165-acre site in Wilyabrup, which showed great potential as a winery. Formerly a dairy farm, transforming the property into a vineyard was an absolute labour of love.

Three hectares of Chardonnay grown across three sites in Margaret River include the Gin Gin clone; the foundation of Western Australia's global dominance with Chardonnay.

The unique Western Australian heritage of the Houghton's clone is included in most of the four hectares of Cabernet.

The Joseph River Estate range represents a winemaking journey underpinned by inspiration, meticulous viticulture, uncompromising commitment to quality, and excellence in winemaking.

Both technical experts at the craft, Mr and Mrs Kooki bend the rules of traditional winemaking when it comes to their label, and dare to be different in their approach to processing. The result? Eminently drinkable wines, that are a little bit Kooki.

Marri Wood Park is a boutique family run and owned, Demeter certified biodynamic vineyard. Established 1992 in Yallingup, Western Australia, located on Caves Road, a stone throw from Smiths Beach.

Their biodynamic philosophy utilises sustainable, chemical free practices.

Applying the timing and movement of celestial objects to predicate pruning, live animal fertilising, and picking; complementing their natural and introduced bio-diversity as an ecologically beneficial approach to farming.

Sixteen acres and ten-thousand vines comprising cabernet sauvignon, sauvignon blanc, chenin blanc, semillon and a terroir of sandy gravelly loam on limestone bedrock. No irrigation; made possible by the dewy, cooling breeze which rolls off the Southern Indian Ocean in conjunction with gentle north facing slopes, undulating

topography and well-established roots of their 28-year-old vines.

The result is hardy vines that produce high quality, robust and delicious grapes. The berries are hand-picked and sorted and then fermented in an array of fermenters (including clay amphoras, French and Austrian oak barrels) to produce the highest quality wine exemplifying the Margaret River region's fine viticultural qualities.




South by South West is a small-batch artisan winemaker based in the Margaret River wine region of Western Australia. They craft wines of excellence and difference that combine respect for the land, with innovative viticultural practices, and both traditional and contemporary winemaking techniques. They aim to to excite and inspire people to enjoy and respect the terroir of the south west through contemporary interpretations that result in balanced, honest wines.

In addition to tending to thier our own organically farmed Wallcliffe vineyard they also purchase fruit from a loyal network of pioneering growers. It's important to them that they can explain the origins of their wine and why they have created each style, and the story behind each wine.

Each wine is given the opportunity to develop its own personality in a small batch where it receives the right amount of attention; personality that is founded on the fruit, and realised through the way it is produced, bottled and labelled. In keeping with the traditional aspects of winemaking, thier style is focused on minimal intervention to showcase regions, varietals, and vineyards in their rightful form.

Their mission is to produce simple wines using great fruit and minimal intervention, to demonstrate the complex characteristics and values that best represent the south west.





Halliday Wine Companion, Tasted by Erin Larkin 2021 Chardonnay 94 points "Fruit from Yallingup (in the north). Hand picked, whole-bunch pressed straight to oak for wild ferment. Matured on full solids for 9 months. Bâtonnage was conducted regularly and mlf occurred in some barrels. For all the work, the cool year has kept this totally in line. It's like a picture of opulence, without actually being opulent. Kind of like a brilliant outdoor fresco. It has crushed nuts, briny acid, toasty oak, salted peach ... it's all there, but it's restrained. Very smart and well handled. Delicious."

Ferguson Valley Western Australia



In the late 1980s Kim and Jenny Robinson were on a mission to find their family the perfect country getaway. Kim, a geologist by trade (and at heart), an uncompromising list of environmental requirements was drafted. He cast his net from Perth to Esperance, and started the search.

After setting foot upon the Ferguson Valley property, and witnessing the beautiful natural waterfall, Kim was sold. The family often travelled down from Perth to the property for weekends with their young children, and Kim came to realise the potential of the land as a vineyard.

Initially established as a contract grower, from 1999 the vineyards produced fruit for a number of award-winning wineries in Western Australia. In 2009, the family made the decision to establish their own footprint, and start the Talisman label.

These days Kim can still be found roaming the vines alongside his daughter Anita Robinson, the winery's vigneron and the second generation of Talisman.

Formerly a four year old member of the rock-jumping, bark-boat-building and bush roaming tribe – Anita now spends her time between Perth and the Geographe Wine Region managing the vines,

and overseeing the winery and cellar door.

Today, the third generation of Talisman's are now in full flight. Anita's eight and six year old daughters, and her older brother Jeremy's daughters of the same age, relish in the same childhood adventures they once boasted of. The walkie talkies are smaller, and the cellar door now proves enormously entertaining with the girls often helping to take orders, but the same picturesque setting is painting the backgrounds of their childhoods in the Ferguson Valley.

"This is well-judged zinfandel showing the fuller flex of the variety with a judicious balance of acidity, fine, chewy tannin and meritorious alcohol levels – no mean feat.

Sure, it's dark plum, cola, dark chocolate, salted licorice and woody spices to the max, but all of that finds a neat measure in perfume and palate. It's even fresh through the finish. It feels like it drinks well now, a caveat that it is powerful, but cellaring should reward further."

SINGLE VINEYARD, HAND PICKED FRUIT, FROM LOW YIELDING 30 YEAR OLD VINES

Margaret River Western Australia



Trait Wines is a cross-continental love story, leading two people from very different parts of the world to salvage an extraordinary old vineyard in Margaret River. It's a story of perseverance, fortitude & family.

Theo Truyts (pronounced 'traits') & Clare Trythall's upbringings were physically & culturally worlds apart. From the wilds of Lesotho in Africa to the colourful life of a British expat in Asia, the duo's lives spanned the globe before their meeting in Western Australia in 2013, he working as a vineyard manager & she as an emergency doctor.

Six years, a wedding, a baby and a wonderfully scruffy dog later, Theo chanced upon a rare opportunity: to assume management of a Margaret River vineyard – one he had worked on early in his time in Australia, and that had left

an indelible impact. Due to its low yields & 'un-machine-able' conditions, it was in danger of abandonment. The thought of this would not leave Theo alone. The sloping site - with vines close-planted more than three decades ago - was producing ever-dwindling yields...but the fruit concentration & the quality was near-on perfection. The cost of running this singular vineyard was almost lunacy. The temptation was too good to refuse.

In 2019, Theo and Clare undertook their first year as fully-fledged independent vignerons, with vintage, a tough season of pruning and Theo grafting a quarter of the vineyard to Chardonnay. They juggled time with their young family and their 'day jobs' alongside the Trait vineyard to make it work, knowing that the precious site

needed hand tending year-round, all the while seeing glimpses of its magnificence.

The "X" that marks all of the Trait bottles is a Truyts family symbol signifying ownership, which was hand- applied to luggage and personal effects. Theo's family used this symbol on travels throughout Central Africa in the mid 20th Century. He still owns antique trunks belonging to his great-grandfather that bear this mark

The wines speak of character, love and the support of family across generations and continents, capturing the glory of the exceptional terroir and vineyard in a bottle.

"While oak is making more of an impact here – the wine is in barrel for 11 months (one-third new), adding a slippery texture and lots of woodsy spices, the fruit handles it. It's also the long line of acidity that pulls all the flavours into line and keeps this thrillingly good. Classy stuff."
