TASTING NOTES

Ruby red colour and displaying rich perfumes of plum, cherry and black pepper. The fruit that you pick up on the nose carry through on the palate making this a quaffable and approachable wine, with tannins that are balanced and support that full mouthfeel.

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

These grapes were sourced from our Central Ranges vineyard in Cowra, with the vineyard itself is situated in an amazing fruit belt which has great access to water and has a temperate summer. This resonates in the fruit we obtain with it displaying balanced PH levels requiring little to no intervention on our part. The shiraz from this property is delicate and light yet displays wonderful fruit flavours of plum and cherry and that always desired hint of pepper.

VINIFICATION

Picked and put into fermentation tanks it was cold soaked for 7 days prior to kicking off the ferment. Once fermented it was placed in a combination of French and Hungarian oak (40% new and 60% old) for a period of 16 months to further develop complexity.

15-16 degrees. Best over the short to medium term.
