This 2022 Inigo Adelaide Hills Pinot Gris shows aromas of nashi pear, peach and jasmine. The palate is clean, fine and well-balanced, allowing the delicate fruit sweetness to shine.

Background Story

A true reflection of provenance, this Pinot Gris is named in honour of Inigo of Loyola who was co-founder of the Jesuit Order whose members built Sevenhill.

Vintage

The 2022 vintage had the ideal foundations; healthy vine canopies and adequate soil moisture, thanks to good winter and late spring rains. The summer months were predominately dry, particularly closer to and during harvest. 2022 was very mild and the cooler nights played a very important roll in the ripening of the fruit.

Moderate yields, rounded out what is one of the best vintages of recent years.

Winemaking

Continuing in 2022, we have collaborated with a reputable grower of Adelaide Hills Pinot Gris, to supply us with this year's wine. The wine was made off site in the Adelaide Hills, which allowed for better management of harvesting times and transport.

The fruit was hand-picked and whole bunch pressed. The pressing fraction was vinified separately. Both portions were cold settled as juice and fermented using a neutral yeast strain.

Standard post ferment settling and filtration occurred post ferment. No oak was used.
