2022 VINTAGE CONDITIONS

In 2022, higher mid-winter rainfall and a cold, windy spring led to a moderate crop level. Downy mildew appeared in the vineyard due to rain and humidity in January and February. The vintage experienced a cool and humid summer influenced by La Nina, resulting in a delayed harvest compared to recent years. However, the wines showcased a newfound brightness and good acidity, reminiscent of past vintages.

Appearance: The Langhorne Creek Malbec showcases a deep and intense purplish-red color, indicating its concentration and depth.

Aroma: The nose is greeted with an enticing array of aromas. Ripe dark berries take center stage, with blackberries and plums dominating the bouquet. There are hints of blueberries and dark cherries, adding complexity and layers of fruitiness. Subtle notes of violets and a touch of spice emerge, contributing to the wine's alluring and aromatic profile.

Palate: On the palate, this Malbec reveals its full-bodied and expressive character. The ripe dark fruit flavors from the nose burst onto the palate, offering a delightful mix of blackberries, plums, and juicy dark cherries.
