VARIETY: Shiraz (60%), Cabernet (40%)
Sauvignon **VINTAGE:** 2020
G.I: Coonawarra | **ALCOHOL:** 13.5%

HARVEST & FERMENTATION: Shiraz and Cabernet hand harvested from our vineyard then fermented separately as 100% whole bunch ferments.

MATURATION: Pressed to tank as individual components prior to blending. Minimal handling leading to maximum flavour.

KATE'S NOTES: This is a wine bursting out of the glass with fragrance. I can picture a big bunch of pink and purple flowers tied up with a strip of raspberry licorice. The palate is generous and juicy. Its creamy texture pushes my focus to a luscious cheesecake with a cherry swirl. So delicious and much to love.

The Wine: Penley's expression of an historical Australian wine classic. Respecting history but with a vivid, optimistic outlook into the future.

The Label: Sophie Merrett has previously worked with Penley Estate on the labels for our 2019 Whole Bunch Cabernet and 2018 Coonawarra Shiraz. The label takes inspiration from the classic 'Comet' design windmill used across the Australian landscape until the inevitable winds of change brought us today's modern wind turbine! Just like the wine, this label represents our take on a classic in a very different landscape.
