The vineyards located along the western edge of the central Barossa Valley are planted in soils riddled with limestone, quartz and marble, and produces wines of intense flavour and firm structure. Wines capable of great longevity, yet also deliciously approachable in their youth.

For over 35 years, Greenock Creek has produced wines defined by their bold flavour, rich character and exceptional longevity. As champions of the style that launched Barossa onto the world's wine stage in the 1990's, we are respectful of that legacy whilst equally committed to the gradual evolution and refinement of our craft in the pursuit of excellence in Barossa winemaking. A focus on single site and sub regional expression guides us in the creation of distinctive and undoubtedly 'Greenock Creek' evocations of classic Barossa varieties such as Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Mataro & Grenache.

Our Roennfeldt Road wines sit comfortably amongst collections of Australia's finest single vineyard wines. Eight Greenock Creek wines have scored a perfect 100 points from the world's leading wine publication *Wine Advocate*, positioning it as Australia's most highly decorated winery with a record that remains unmatched.

Renowned for an uncompromising approach to making Barossa wine of the most exceptional quality, demand for our wines has always outstripped supply. A loyal and passionate following has been built around the fruits of our labour, and we pride ourselves on fulfilling a promise of boldly expressive Barossan wines.
