- Palate* Black cherry, chocolate, mocha, orange and spice; fully integrated tannins.

HARVEST DATE	30th March
VINIFICATION	40% whole bunch. In vat for 28 days
AGEING	20 months new French oak barriques (Remond: Alliers, Troancais and Betranges forests)
