SIX GENERATIONS of stubborn, competitive growers and one equally spirited winemaker - that's the Oliver family. Living smack bang in the middle of McLaren Vale, they flourish on producing perfect parcels of fruit on their 100 hectare 'Taranga' vineyard.

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TARANGA

OLIVER'S TARANGA is situated within the northern hills of McLaren Vale, renowned for rich soils and sea breezes, ensuring gradual ripening of grape berries with concentrated flavours and balance. The property consists of over 100 hectares of vineyards planted to a number of different varieties of red and white grapes.

In 1839, William and Elizabeth Oliver left Roxburghshire, Scotland to settle in McLaren Vale on two farms 'Whitehill' and 'Taranga'. In 1841 the first vineyards were planted, along with orchards and the farm cleared for cropping and grazing of sheep and cattle.

CORRINA

Corrina Wright has wine – and 171 years of family grape growing – flowing through her veins. Described by WBM Magazine as a "legend in the making" and by James Halliday as being part of a "remarkable dynasty" she's treading a slightly different path among the vines that her forefathers planted, in the Seaview sub-region of McLaren Vale.

OLIVERS FARANCI INFELLES

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SMALL BATCH

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WITH 100ha of premium grapevines on the Taranga property, the Oliver family has over 50 blocks representing different grape varieties, clones, soil types and vine ages. Each vintage, different varieties and blocks will show their strength and from this has been born the 'Small Batch' range.

PREMIUM WINE

M53 branded the finest Taranga herd back in 1880 and now, more than 135 years later, it marks Taranga's finest wine, only released in the best vintages.

HJ was a lover and a fighter. He fought to win the affection of his sweetheart Marjorie, before serving in WWII. He then fought to realise his vision of seeing the 'Taranga' property produce only high quality grapes.

DJ is a man of few words; as straight up and down as the prized rows of vines he cares for. Hi passion for grape growing is only exceeded by his passion for his family and sport.



FORTIFIED

ARCHIBALD Oliver inherited 800 acres of the family property when pioneer William passed away in 1888 but it was Archibald's stern wife Ruth, whom he married in 1879. that kept the family business in health while Archibald and his brothers led a more scurrilous lifesyle.

Since 1841, William Oliver and his descendants have grown premium wine grapes on their McLaren Vale 'Taranga' property. Three brothers from the second generation avoided the trials of family farming, preferring to live the 'good life' of drinking, smoking and gambling. A true family history wouldn't be complete without remembering the 'banished' brothers.
