Peccavi 'No Regrets' Sauvignon Blanc Semillon 2022

This quintessential Margaret River wine style personifies region and lifestyle. The wine's aroma is generous and punchy with layers of tropical fruits; it is crisp and dry with the palate displaying ripe nectarines, passionfruit and guava, the finish is clean and refreshing.

Peccavi 'No Regrets' Chardonnay 2021

The No Regrets Chardonnay is pale gold and lemon in colour, with subtle aromas of nectarine and hints of toasted cashew. On the palate is porcelain white pear and sliced stone fruit draped in fresh minerality, rounded off with praline and brioche notes to finish.

Peccavi 'No Regrets' Cabernet Merlot 2021

Saturated fuchsia in colour with a fragrant bouquet of bright red and black fruit, vibrant, full of energy with chocolatey oak and hints of spice. Full to medium bodied, soft, plush with a juicy core of berry fruit and well-integrated tannins.

Peccavi Sauvignon Blanc 2020

Pale straw colouring and a bouquet of gooseberries, cassis and a hint of tropical fruits backed by faintly smoky vanilla oak. The palate displays great clarity and purity with a spectrum of lemon, lime and grapefruit unfolding to a palate that has capacity, volume and delicate textures. Precise acidity captures and creates a defined palate of vibrancy, finishing with a balanced crunchy lemon acidity.

Peccavi Chardonnay 2021

Flint, nectarines and toasted cashews are dotted with subtle aromas of jasmine and brioche. A fine and focused entry of wet slate, white pear and porcelain fruit tannin, draped in sheets of crushed granite and quenching minerality. Firm and persistent to finish, laced with yet more white fruit and nougat.

Peccavi Syrah 2022

This Syrah is powerful, modern, Rhône-inspired with peppery, spicy aromas of blackberries, dark plum and blueberries. There are hints of fresh chocolate/mocha oak and dried herbs. Underpinned by fine, dusty tannins, it is medium to full bodied, with a lingering core of dark fruit and smoky oak. This wine has fine poise and savoury balance.

Peccavi Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

The Peccavi Cabernet Sauvignon 2019 is made up of 94% Cabernet from our two Bordeaux Clones and 6% from our own Petit Verdot. On the nose comes a depth of aromas, summer fruits with cassis at the forefront, some rum and raisin and maybe a hint of chocolate. Behind this are fine layers of lifted flowers, nuances of a musk perfume that smells deep and rich. Structurally this is a powerful wine with an incredibly smooth texture and a wonderful mouthfeel that affirms the fine velvet tannins. The wine finishes with a great length and will be enjoyed for years to come.

Peccavi 'Old Block' Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

Deep colour with purple hues, this blockbuster of a Margaret River Cabernet shows lifted aromas of mulberry, briar, and blackcurrant with a hint of bay leaf with echoes of cedar and vanilla in the background. The palate displays a fine acidity coupled with soft velvety tannin and finishes clean with a lingering aftertaste of blackcurrant and mocha.

Peccavi Petit Verdot 2020

A deep purple colour with aroma characteristics of black fruit; plum, blackberry, with floral notes of violet, lilac, lavender, sage, and herbs. The grape has brilliant colour, tannin, acidity, and a savoury herbaceous quality. Oak age softens the profile and adds vanilla, nutty notes, and cocoa.

Peccavi 'The Estate' Merlot 2019

This Merlot offers aromas of black cherries and chocolate with hints of oak and dried herbs. Full to medium-bodied wine, it provides a long, elegant and silky texture with deep flavours of plums, berries, oak and earthly herbs.

Peccavi 'The Estate' Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

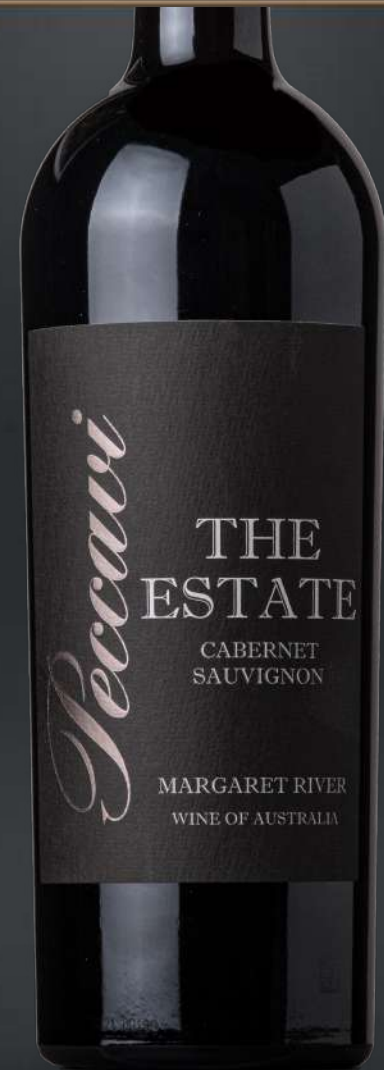
This Cabernet Sauvignon has a dense deep purple hue; it offers a lifted opulent nose of blackberries, blueberries, and anise, along with fine layers of mint, nutmeg and hints of other spices. This medium to full-bodied wine offers on the palate dense flavours of berry fruits and spicy notes, the tannins are soft with a velvet like texture and the acidity weaves it way from front to back in a seamless fashion, leaving the wine with a savoury yet fruity finish, very delicious.
