

WATERVALE RIESLING

VINTAGE 2023



TASTING NOTES

This vineyard has classic Watervale soils - red loam over limestone with a westerly aspect. The limestone allows the soil to retain moisture, which assists the wine throughout periods of warm weather, almost drought-proofing in the summer months.

Our latest vintage is a pale straw colour, showing lifted notes of kaffir lime and fennel. Elegant on the palate with a purity of lemon-lime citrus fruit, balanced by a tight acid backbone.
