Colour

Blush petal pink with light salmon hues.

Bouquet

Lifted floral aromatics with hints of fresh strawberry. Delicate red cherry and floral notes intertwine seamlessly.

Palate

The palate is fine and textural. With delicate red fruits on the front palate. Fresh flavours of strawberry, ripe raspberry and a hint of honeydew melon, balances beautifully with the acidity delivering a crisp and dry finish.

Winemaking

Hand Picked from 60-year-old Grenache Bush Grown Vines at the Beresford Estate Vineyard in Blewitt Springs. The must was chilled for less than 1 hour on the Grenache grape skins to extract the lovely subtle pink colour pigments. Bottled young to capture the fresh red fruits of our old Grenache bush vine. A light, crisp and delicate style, suited to hot days, served ice cold.

No animal products have been used in the fining or filtering process of this wine. Vegan Friendly.
