Kevin Mitchell's father Mort respected this man from the bush, as they both knew the secrets of the rich landscape. Killerman's Run reflects the rich landscape and being at one with the environment by sourcing and blending wines from right across the Clare Valley into a seamless, natural and uncompromising wine.

PLACE

The Killerman's Run range of wines are masterfully composed blends selected from across the finest vineyards and sub regions in the Clare Valley.



VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A dry yet cooler vintage, 2019 has delivered smaller yields of highly-flavoured fruit. The lower than average rainfall between December and harvest created a few challenges, but through careful fruit selection and final blending, this classic final cuvée really shows what the Clare Valley can deliver.

WINEMAKING

Each individual parcel was vinified separately, and remained so until the final wine was assembled. Maturation in a selection of seasoned French oak hogsheads for fifteen months provides a softness and elegance to the silky palate.

COLOUR

Deep, dark red.

NOSE

Black forest, dark cherry and stewed plums with vanilla, clove and subtle oaky char.

PALATE

Stewed cherries, juicy blackberry and plum with fine dark chocolate and powdery tannins. Clove and star anise in support with balanced oak.
