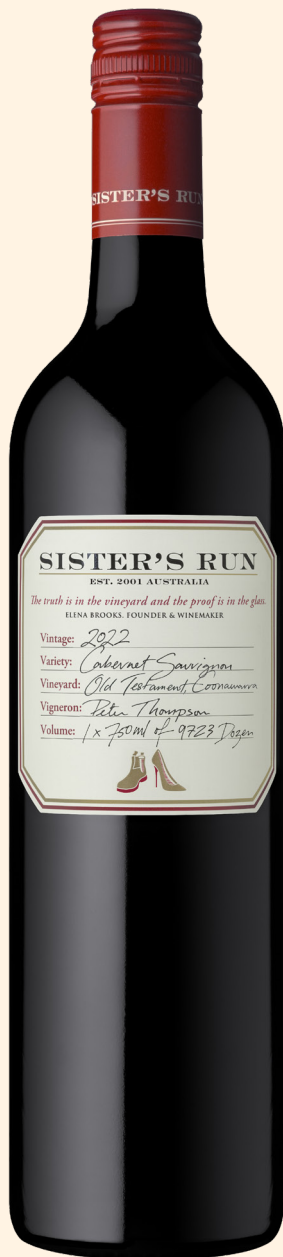

About Us:

Colour:

Ruby-black that is bright and alive.

Nose:

Aromatics so evocative of cabernet: cassis, rhubarb, blackberry... And then the bouquet of a gentle oak's cedar and pine. Aroma and bouquet meld all too effortlessly, to make you think that one may be the other. As cabernet should be.

Palate:

Dry and LONG... Textural clouds of fine tannins are present from whoa to go. Red berry fruits jump about in this mix, rounded and full, yet then leaner and meaner. The true champion is the acid structure. Taut and long, countering the ripe dark and blackberry fruits.

In Summary:

Good cabernet's tannin and black fruits require certain company. From a simple butcher's best sausage to a posh butcher's finest Scotch Fillet. Cut your cloth, as they say.
