Appearance

Deep ruby

Aroma / Bouquet

Intense nose of rhubarb and raspberry, lightened by a hint of tarragon

Palate

A full, generous palate with an earthy depth. Intense raspberry characters leading to a long, finely balanced palate, with just a hint of oak.

Serve

At room temperature 16-20°C

Cellar

Peak drinking now, till at least 2029.

Food pairing

Steak bearnaise. Osso bucco with polenta. Pasta Bolognese. Hard cheeses.

Vineyard

100% Estate grown shiraz from the rich loams of Siegersdorf vineyard in the heart of Barossa Valley. Altitude 250-270m

Season

The season saw a healthy average rainfall resulting in higher yields across the region. We saw a little rain leading into vintage with the resulting fruit ripening consistently.

Winemaking

Destemmed and fermented in small stainless fermenters at 18-25 deg. Pumped over 2x daily for 20 minutes. Pressed at dryness, left to settle and complete mlf then filtered to oak or full ss

Maturation

12 months in French older oak. Mixture of oak and stainless steel.
