

2020 TAMBLYN CABERNET SAUVIGNON/ SHIRAZ/MALBEC/MERLOT

The family name 'Tamblyn' is in recognition of our grandmother's ancestors who migrated to Australia from Cornwall, England.

The Tamblyn is a seamless blend showing a complex flavour profile with a soft tannin finish that expresses the individual characteristics of the 4 classic varietals used.

The Cabernet Sauvignon provides the framework, Shiraz adds berry fruit weight, Malbec adds a perfumed lift and intense colour and the Merlot rounds out the palate.

REGION: Langhorne Creek

VARIETY: 49% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Shiraz

6% Malbec and 5% Merlot

CELLARING: Drink now or cellar for 3- 5 years

SERVE: Charcuterie, pizza, pasta, cheese especially with

family and friends.

WINEMAKING: The components for Tamblyn were individually

fermented in open top fermenters which allowed for optimal extraction of colour and flavour. The wine was matured in a combination of new and old French and American barrels for 18months before
