Growing Conditions

A beautiful growing season, with dry weather during winter followed by lovely spring rains, rejuvenating the vineyards. Great canopies, healthy vines and an abundance of water made one of the hottest years on record easy to manage, with grapes picked at normal to later than average days than in previous years. Great flavours and wonderful acidities a feature of 2019.

Colour

Pale straw with bright green hues.

Aroma

Classic citrus characters of lime & lemongrass predominate with wonderful intensity and purity.

Palate

An elegant yet intense palate of pure Semillon fruit providing great line and length.

Vinification/Maturation

A combination of machine and hand harvesting in the early morning. Transported, destemmed to press where only 500 litres per tonne of the finest free run was taken. Settled, racked and inoculated for a clean & cold fermentation which took 14 days. Chilled and fined before bottling.
