2018 Cabernets

A blend of varieties from the Cabernet family made from organically grown fruit in the Frankland River region of the Great Southern. 2018 was a long mild and dry growing season that resulted in grapes of fantastic flavours and ripeness. Harvested in late April, fermented and hand plunged in open pot fermenters and matured in 500l French oak barrels. A complex mix of briar, cedar and spice initially. This is followed by ripe mulberries and plum that lift out of the glass with fresh liveliness. Hints of earthy and leathery notes slowly creep in. Juicy red berries on the front of the palate are followed by plums and black jube that are intertwined with a lovely grainy tannin that gives the wine structure. Mulberry, blackcurrant and chocolate flavours linger in the background and add a lovely balance. The oak adds a nice creamy vanilla flavour. This wine is medium bodied yet powerful.

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
