

The Schulz family take over Fiedler's land and establish a thriving butchery. A bluestone butchers shop is constructed close to the Tanunda Creek and along the thoroughfare between the villages of Tanunda and Bethanien.

1987: VINE PULL SCHEME

In response to the 'wine glut' of the late 1980s the South Australian Government introduced the 'vine-pull scheme' in 1987. This scheme rewarded growers who pulled their vines and exited the industry, unfortunately resulting in the destruction of much of the priceless living history of the Barossa Valley. The historical importance of the Turkey Flat property was recognised by Christie Schulz and saved the only way possible, by buying in and starting a new, boutique winery.

For the first time in 100 years fruit from the Ancestor vines planted in 1847 on the Bethany Road 'Turkey Flat' property was used to make a dry table red. - and what is to become an icon - Turkey Flat Shiraz.








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Why Turkey Flat?

Turkey Flat is the local name for the vineyard property and is believed to be so named by the original settlers in the late 1840's after the large flocks of native bush turkeys (Australian Bustard) in the area.

Local artist Rod Schubert was commissioned for the design of the label. It is his depiction of the native bush turkey that gives bottles of Turkey Flat wine their distinctive elegance. 4

blueberry, chocolate and cocoa powder.











Turkey Flat ROSÉ

Grenache.

The Turkey Flat Rosé is the result of nearly thirty years of refinement in technique.

Our style has become archetypal of Australian Rosé, with fresh, aromatic fruit, florals and spice on the nose, satisfying body and texture on the palate, and a clean, savoury-shift on the finish.

Grenache is the star of this wine and is picked in multiple parcels across the vintage to provide the components for a wine that is a masterclass in blending.

Turkey Flat BUTCHERS BLOCK RED

Shiraz. Grenache. Mataro

Named in honour of our family's original use for the building that now houses our Cellar Door, the Butchers Block Red is a structured, fruit driven & medium bodied wine. A crowd-pleasing style of wine that offers excellent value for money.

Each varietal is vinified & aged individually in French oak barrels before the final blending process. Shiraz adds the generous mouthfeel, Grenache the spice and cherry-like sweetness and Mataro the backbone, savoury edge and fragrance. Balance is crucial, each varietal's contribution is evident, yet nothing competes for your attention.

Medium-bodied palate with juicy dark berry fruits, blueberries, violets, graphite and flint, held together with fine, supple tannins.

Turkey Flat GRENACHE

Planted in 1920

Turkey Flat has more than 25 years experience in making Grenache. This older variety for South Australia has a natural home in the Barossa, although respect for the variety as a maker of fine wine has only recently been achieved. It has been an important part of the Turkey Flat range since 1992.

Beautiful floral and spiced aromatics, bright fruit that fills out into more complex spiced and savoury characteristics, and strong tannins that will ensure longevity.





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
